- Infection Prevention Goods
- Stockpiles at shelters are limited and relief supplies will not arrive immediately. Prepare food and water
 for yourself and your family (at least for 3 days, preferably 1 week x number of people), and also daily
 necessities (portable toilets, etc.).
- * "Rolling stock" is a recommended stockpiling method, in which you buy a little more food you use on a daily basis and then buy more as you consume more.


