#### LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE PREMIUM DETERMINED

Notification and Statement of Long-term Care Insurance Premium had been mailed to citizens over 65 years old. The premium collected from citizens is crucial to operate this insurance system.

◆ Age 40 ~ 64 years (secondary insurer)

Medical Insurance premium (National Health Insurance or other) and Care Insurance premium are collected together.

◆ Age 65 years and older (priority insurer)

This insurance premium is determined into 11 levels in proportion to the household's income of previous year. For detailed information on this insurance premium, please refer to the statement or contact *Kourei Fukushi Kaiqoka* in city hall.

◆ Collection methods for priority insurer

· Special Collection – premium deducted from pension payment.

Those who receive yearly pension over ¥180,000 are subject to this collection method. The applicable pension types are retirement pension, surviving family pension, disability pension.

· Normal Collection – premium paid with statement or by bank transfer

Those who receive yearly pension less than ¥180,000, and those who receive other types of pension than that of special collection are subject to this collection method.

\*those applicable to the following conditions must pay as normal collection despite the special collection eligibility .... Those turning 65 years old, or those starting to receive pension, or those moving into *Hamura* city during this fiscal year. Those whose pension is suspended. Those repaying debt of *Nenkintanpo* Loan.

\*Normal collection premium payment can be made at some stores, if you receive a statement with a barcode. The list of registered stores is on the back of a statement.

✤ If you are wishing to receive Long-term Care Insurance Benefit

First thing is first! Please feel free to consult with advisors in *Chiiki Houkatsu Shien* Center or *Kourei Fukushi Kaigoka* in city hall. Long-term Care Insurance cannot be applied to services by simply showing the beneficiary's ID unlike the system of Health Insurance. An insurance beneficiary must obtain a *Youkaigo Nintei* (Care Insurance Beneficiary Certificate).

✤ A long-time premium defaulter, unless a decent reason is approved, will be subject to penalty and possible benefit reduction in accordance with the period in arrears.

If you have a difficulty with paying insurance premium, please consult with an appropriate department in city office so not to neglect the outstanding balance.

\* There is a reduction or postponement of payment offered for cases of severe property damage by fire or water disaster. Please contact for details.

\*Those who made the previous payments by bank transfer will not receive a statement.

\*Those who turned 75 years old or enrolled in elderly medical insurance or relocated after April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2009 are subject to special collection (withdrawal from pension) starting April 2010, therefore will receive the notification and statement.

## Guide to having dog pets

and a statement.

 $\cdot$  Use a lead on your dog(s). According to Tokyo regulation, keeping a dog unleashed is prohibited. Always keep your dog(s) leashed, and keep it short so you can take a prompt action as needed.

• Pick up and take Dog Droppings with you

When taking your dog for a walk, always carry plastic bags, pick up your dog's droppings, and <u>take</u> <u>them back home</u> for proper disposal.

## Guide to having cat pets

 $\cdot$  Surgical castration is recommended. By this, you can prevent diseases such as Mammary Gland Tumor. In addition, it will ease-up the mating calls, cat fighting, and urine odor.

 $\cdot$  Keeping cats indoor is recommended. To keep cats indoor comfortably, provide cats an atmosphere where they can climb vertically. Also having a cat toilet (litter box), and a scratching post is helpful.

In these days, the number of young women with low bone density has been increasing. Bone density checks are not only for those who are about to/have experienced menopause. Younger people should have a bone density check as well to determine if their bones are in good condition. #### <Is your vaccination record updated? Immunization Information>

Getting vaccinated is the best solution to prevent your child from any communicable disease.

Caution -- Things to remember / Some vaccines require multiple vaccinations. Depending on the type of vaccines, you may need to wait a certain length of time for the next vaccine. There are adequate and general ages set for each vaccination. If your child is older than the age specified for those vaccines, a vaccine fee will be charged (normally the fee is covered by public funds). Plan ahead and get your vaccinations on time.

 $\cdot$  BCG vaccine / 3 months to 5 months old

 $\cdot$  Polio / 3 months to 7 years and 5 months old

 $\cdot$  DPT vaccine (Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Tetanus) / 3 doses of vaccine (3 months to 7 years and 5 months old). Wait 20 to 56 days between each dose of vaccine. a Booster Shot (4th dose) is given 12 to 18 months after the completion of the 3rd dose(3 months to 7 years and 5 months old).

 $\cdot$  DT vaccine (Diphtheria and Tetanus) / 6<sup>th</sup> graders (Children of age 11 to 12 years old)

 $\cdot$  MR vaccine (Measles, and Rubella) / 1st dose (12 months old), 2nd dose (5 to 6 years old (during the year before enrollment to elementary school))

\* As a transitional measure of vaccine regulation revision, children in 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade need to have booster shots. 3rd dose (12 to 13 year olds), 4th dose (17~18 year olds)
