DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS SUPPORT ALLOWANCE

This allowance applies to those households who cannot receive *Teigaku Kyufukin* (Supplementary Income Payments) or *Kosodate Ouen Tokubetsu Teate* (Special Child Rearing Support Allowance) due to unregistered address change concerning refuge from domestic violence.

Eligibility: those who had consulted with public office as domestic violence victims before February 1st 2009 and received support. Need to show a proof of the support. (except those who had already received support of equivalent amount to this allowance)

MEDICAL SUBSIDY for COMPULSORY EDUCATION CHILDREN

The support amount will increase from October 1st 2009. Beneficiary's cost will change as follows:

- Per doctor visit ¥200 (inclusive of surgery, not inclusive of medicine and home nurse care)
- Hospitalization free of charge (not inclusive of meal cost)

*Medical treatment that is not covered by National Health Insurance is not subject to this subsidy.

*children under the following condition(s) are not entitled to this subsidy: unregistered beneficiary of National Health Insurance, lawfully admitted to a Children's facility appointed by Child Welfare Act, beneficiary of livelihood protection, under foster home care.

◆ an applicable child (compulsory education attendant) needs a registration to benefit from this subsidy. Visit *Kosodate Shienka* for a registration with the following requirements – seal (*Inkan* of non-inked type), the child's health insurance card, the parent's health insurance card (if the parent is an Employees' Pension Insurance beneficiary) and/or Certificate of National Pension (if the parent is a National Health Insurance beneficiary).

◆ if a registrant had a residence registry outside of *Hamura* city as of January 1st 2009, he/she needs to obtain a taxation statement of 2009 issued by municipality of former residence. (if obtaining it in August or September, taxation statement of 2008)
