#### **ECOLOGICAL DRIVING**

#### How You Can Save the Environment & Your Fuel Budget

Introduced here are some simple things you can practice when you drive a car.

Each of these acts of kindness will help prevent global warming, and save your fuel budget as well!

- **Gentle Acceleration** By stepping on the gas gently, you can save your fuel by approximately 11%. Aim at 20km/ph in the first 5 seconds from the start, then let the speed pick up gradually.
- Minimize Braking & Accelerating The more often you step on the brake and gas, the worse your fuel efficiency becomes (by approximately 2% in city area, 6% in outskirts). Also, putting the gear in the high when driving fast will help save your fuel.
- Advantage of Engine Brake Engine brake functions to decelerate by stop feeding gas, therefore, helps to improve the fuel efficiency (by approximately 2%). Take full advantage of this effect when you mean to down your speed rather than stepping on the brake only.
- **Minimize Air-conditioner Use** Relying on air-conditioner tends to eat up more fuel than you think. Try to open the window in this comfortable season, rather than turning on your car air-conditioner.
- Idling approximately 130cc of gas is wasted by 10minute idling (neutral gear, air-conditioner off). Also, car exhaust is a nuisance to the neighbors. Please be considerate, and refrain from idling.
- No More Pre-driving Warm-up Recently manufactured cars do not require pre-driving engine warm-up for better fuel efficiency. They are equipped with a function to warm-up the engine as you drive. 5 minute pre-driving engine warm-up consumes approximately 160cc of fuel.
- **Know Your Route** If you spend 10 minutes out of 1-hour driving looking for a way to destination, the fuel efficiency downs by approximately 14%. Check your route by road information beforehand.
- Tire Air Pressure If your tire's air pressure is lower than the tire manufacture's recommended pressure by 50kPa, the fuel efficiency downs by approximately 2% in city areas, and 4% in outskirts. Maintain proper air pressure to prolong their life, to ensure the best gas mileage and for safe handling.
- Weight Down Your Car 100kg of unnecessary baggage weight can decrease the fuel efficiency by approximately 3%. Off-load unnecessary goods from your car, and drive smart.
- **Street Parking** Inconsiderately parked cars are the major cause for traffic congestion which result in excess gas emission. When the average road traffic speed downs from 40km/ph to 20km/ph, the fuel efficiency also downs by approximately 31%.

Let's be considerate for the traffic around you in which you are also a part of when you drive.

#### **NEW BICYCLE RULES**

Please take this chance to reflect on your bicycle-ride behavior. Are you well complying with the traffic rules? Double riding, riding under a influence of alcohol, parallel riding of multiple riders, ignoring traffic lights are all strictly prohibited by the traffic law. Turning on the bike-light in dark and coming to stop at an intersection are some of the strongly recommended safety majors.

In addition to the above well known bicycle rules, new rules had become in effect in July 2009.

- ◆ Riding with umbrella use is prohibited
- ◆ Riding while using a mobile phone is prohibited
- lacktriangle Riding with up to two infants(age 6 years or younger) are permitted under restricted conditions  $\mbox{$\downarrow$}$

Driver must be over 16 years old

Infants must be appropriately seated on the securely installed infant seats.

Driver is forbidden to carry a child on one's back while having two infants on the ride Driver and children are strongly recommended to ware safety helmets.

# Let's prevent the spread of NEW TYPE INFLUENZA!

Influenza is a communicable disease – you could get the Flu by inhaling or touching the virus which is spread by coughing and sneezing. Most people are not immune to the New Type Flu.

#### How to prevent Flu (not to catch it, not to spread it)

- · Wash your hands and gargle as soon as you arrive home each day
- · Wear a mask if you are coughing or sneezing
- · When coughing/sneezing, cover your mouth and nose and face away from people around you.

# If you think you have the Flu...

- \* Any medical facility in Tokyo will take Flu patients. To prevent severe flu symptoms, see a physician and get treated as soon as possible.
- \* Expectant mothers, infants, and those with respiratory disease or diabetes have a tendency to react severely to the flu. Please consult with a physician for treatment.
- \* Normally healthy persons may also have a severe reaction to the flu. If you feel ill, contacting a physician is recommended.

# **Recuperation at Home**

Take prescribed medication and rest at home. If you still feel very ill, consult with a physician. After your temperature returns to normal, staying at home for two full days is strongly recommended. Also, in order to minimize the chance of spreading the virus, refrain from going out for 7 days from when you start running a fever or any other symptom such as coughing and sore throat.

#### What should family member do?

When taking care of patients, you should wear a mask and wash your hands afterwards. If possible, stay in a separate room.
