ABANDONED BICYCLES CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN

○Help Wheelchair People – Bicycles left on the street make walkways very narrow, causing problems for those in wheelchairs and or with strollers.

○Please be aware that illegally parked bicycles cause accidents on the streets, and annoyance to elderly people, children and neighboring businesses. Always park bicycles in certified parking areas.
Prohibited Zone for Parking Bicycles: Areas within 400 meters radius from *Hamura* and *Ozaku* Stations.

● A piece larger than 50cm in length must be taken apart into smaller pieces. A large piece is not accepted into the incinerator, due to its' structure which contains a propelling screw.
