 \Rightarrow Respect for their seniors and predecessors - for children and young youth, 'having respect to someone' is to like the person, and to have a feeling of appreciation towards the person.

 \Rightarrow Put them through experiences. Young people are trained by going through difficulties, failure, and dangerous experiences in order to develop an ability to foresee the result of their actions.

 \Rightarrow Help them open up to talk about their day. Let's start by listening to them. If they are comfortable talking with you, the conversation will help you catch a signal of their troubles.

INFLUENZA (A/H1N1) VACCINATION

Vaccination will soon be available for the novel influenza A/H1N1 which is often called New Type Flu or Swine Flu. Vaccine is available only for the specific population groups that are given priority at this time (refer to a table below). Starting dates shown in the table is estimate. An official announcement will follow as the information becomes available.

Two doses per person with $1 \sim 4$ week interval between doses is prospected, however, the dosage may be revised for some or all population groups.

* Please be aware of the possibility of serious side effects reported to rarely occur from the influenza vaccination. Effectiveness of this vaccine is not guaranteed for all people.

Vaccination Cost: First Dose ¥3600, Second Dose ¥2550 *¥3600 each dose if taken at different facilities. * An appointment and a proof of your eligibility are required to receive vaccinations. Please present an identification such as Maternal and Child Health Handbook, Insurance Card, Student ID, Resident Registry, Driver' License or '*Yuusen Sesshu Taishousha Shoumeisho* (Certificate of Priority Person for Influenza Vaccination)' issued by your regular doctor.
