## THE PUBLIC E-CERTIFICATION SERVICE FOR INDIVIDUAL AUTHENTICATION

Saturday Service will be temporarily available during January 8<sup>th</sup>(Sat) ~ March 12<sup>th</sup>(Sat), 8:30AM~Noon and 1PM~4:30PM. The system will be closed on Sundays. Weekday service hours are 8:30AM~4:30PM. This public certification system issues electronic-based individual authentication certificate, which will allow the certificate holders to use online public services such as tax filing and other administrative procedures. ## NOTIFICATION OF SCHOOL DESIGNATION AND ENTRANCE DATE

Notification of School Designation and Entrance Date (入学期日および学校指定通知書) will be mailed to the households of children who are entering to an elementary school or a junior high school from April 2011.

- ◆ If any of the following cases apply to you, or if you are expecting the notification but it does not reach you by late January, please contact us.
  - Home address will change due to moving before the end of March 2011.
  - The child is expected to enter to a private school.
  - Foreign resident who are planning to enter to a *Hamura* City municipal school
  - Home address is within the Yokota Air Base.
- ◆ Your child is eligible to change the designation of school for any of the following reasons.
  - The family has a definite plan to move away from the current school district.
  - Your child is expected to graduate from an elementary school away from his/her original district and wishes to enter to a junior high school of the same district as the current elementary school.

## **NATIONAL PENSION (*KOKUMIN NENKIN*) PROGRAM ENROLLMENT**

The National Pension (*Kokumin Nenkin*) is a social security system operated by the national government in which everyone pays into a financial pool of insurance premiums mostly in preparation for life after retirement from work. This system will also provide financial support to an insured person in case of becoming handicapped, or to the surviving family members in case of an insured person's death.

Everyone between 20 and 60 years of age who lives in Japan, regardless of nationality, must enroll in National Pension. However, those who are already enrolled in Welfare Annuity (*Kousei Nenkin*) or a Mutual Aid Association Pension Plan (*Kyousai Kumiai Nenkin*) at their place of employment, and spouses of such members, are not obligated to enroll in National Pension.

If you are at applicable age and not enrolled in National Pension, Welfare Annuity or Mutual Aid Association Pension Plan, please come to city hall for a consultation to know the necessary procedure. National Pension Brochure and Enrollment Application will be mailed to the residents who will turn 20 years old this year. Please fill in the form and bring it to *Hoken Nenkin-ka*.

### **JANUARY 31<sup>st</sup> (Mon) – Due Date for Some Tax Payments**

Payment for the 4<sup>th</sup> installment of Resident Tax, and payment for the 7<sup>th</sup> installment of National Health Insurance Tax, Long-term Care Insurance Tax and Late-elderly Medical Insurance Tax is due on January 31<sup>st</sup> (Mon).

### **INCOME TAX RETURN – Filing is accepted from January 4<sup>th</sup>**

If your current income tax withholding (calculated based on the income of last year) is greater than the actual taxable amount of this year (calculated based on income of this year), please prepare and file an Income Tax Return Certificate (*Kanpu Shinkoku*) in order to receive the refund of the difference. Please make sure to file the certificate at your earliest chance, preferably before the tax office's busiest season in mid February to mid March.

### **CHANGE OF TAXATION METHOD ON INSURANCE PENSION**

Please be informed that the method of taxation on pension income pertaining to inherited or donated Life or Casualty Insurance Policy will be reformed. Due to this reform, some portion of the already paid income tax levied on insurance pension may become a subject of refund. For details, please refer to the website of National Tax Agency (in Japanese) or contact *Ōme Tax Office* (☎0428-22-3185).

### **LAND PROPERTY STATUS REPORT**

Land owners who own land property in *Hamura City*, if his/her land property meets any of the following conditions, are required to report the change of land use status before January 31<sup>st</sup> (Mon) 2011.

- Changed the use purpose of land property due to building a new house on the site
- Had a house demolished, and no longer using the site for housing
- Newly built a business property on the property site
- Changed the use purpose of building on the site from a residential housing to a commercial space
