HAMURA CITY HAS DELIVERED RELIEF SUPPLIES

Relief goods for *Touhoku* disaster victims were donated from local enterprises and also collected from the city's emergency reserve supplies. *Hamura* City had sent three city hall employees with trucks, on three trips during March 31st through April 28th, to deliver some of those relief goods directly to *Ishinomaki* City in *Miyagi*, *Souma* City in *Fukushima* and *Rikuzen-Takata* City in *Iwate*. *Hamura* City had also sent some of the relief goods to *Mito* City in *Ibaragi*, *Oosato-chou* and *Takajou* City in *Miyagi* and *Aizu-Wakamatsu* City in *Fukushima* through the cooperation of other public bodies.

The donated relief supplies included: Cooking Paper, Diapers for Adult, Working Clothes, Winter Clothes, "Hamura" brand Bottled Waters, Anonymous Brand Bottled Water, Survival Foods, Cup Noodles, Instant Rice, Instant Miso-soups, Packaged Curry, Snacks, Dry-cell Batteries.

HAMURA CITY HAS SENT RELIEF AID MONEY

The total amount of donation money for Great East Japan Earthquake Victims entrusted with *Hamura* City was ¥21,499,762 as of May 6th (Fri). From this fund the city has sent ¥5,000,000 in direct remittance to each of prefectural offices of *Iwate, Miyagi and Fukushima* on April 22nd (Fri). Thank you very much for all your contributions. The remaining amount will be combined with more contributions to come, and will be sent again to the administrative office of severely affected *Touhoku* prefectures.

HAMURA CITY TAP WATER QUALITY TEST

In Hamura City, our tap water supply is sourced from the local underground water.

The city has commissioned external agencies to conduct tap water quality test focusing on radioactive substances (radioiodine, radioactive cesium 134 and 137). The tests have been regularly conducted twice a week since March 23rd. Up to date, all of the past test results shown no trace of radioactive substances detected, which approved that *Hamura* City's tap water is safe for our daily use and drinking. REDUCTION and EXEMPTION of NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM

There is a reduction, exemption or deferred collection system of self-pay portion of medical expense for the victims of a disaster and for persons in especially difficult financial situation due to sickness or unemployment. HAVE YOU PAID ALL YOUR TAXES DUE?

City Taxes corrected by local residents are used to fund the local public services, and Tax for National Health Insurance is used for managing the secure medical environment around the country where people in Japan are able to receive medical care when in need. All taxes are important financial source which we need to build and manage a safe and secure society for all people living in Japan.

Hamura City sends tax payment reminders to residents who have taxes in arrears. If you received any postcard/letter from city administration, but have trouble reading Japanese, please do not hesitate to consult city hall staff in order to avoid a possible penalty for unpaid tax. If you are not confident understanding the matters regarding any administrative procedures done in city hall, we suggest that you visit or contact with city hall for assistance without delay.

LIGHT VEHICLE TAX

Tax Notification of Light Vehicle (軽自動車税納税通知書) was mailed to the applicable vehicle owners in early May. Light Vehicle Tax is levied on the registered owner based on the registration information confirmed on April 1st. Light Vehicle Tax payment is accepted at designated financial institutions and at convenience stores (the list is printed on the notification).

♦ There is tax exemption system for a light vehicle owned and used by disabled people. Application must be filed before May 24th (Tue) for the exemption. Those who received this exemption during last year and <u>changed</u> his/her vehicle need to file an application again. Please contact for application details. APPLICATION for CHILD SUPPORT ALLOWANCE (Jidou Ikusei Teate)

June is the beginning month of a fiscal year for Child Support Allowance Program. Those who wish to newly apply or try reapplying this year, please file an application before May 31st (Tue).

Current recipients of Child Support Allowance will receive a mailed Current State Report Form (現況届用 紙) in June. Please submit the report by the deadline stated on the form. For procedure details and required items for application, please contact with *Kosodate Shien-ka Shien-kakari*.

♦ Child Support Allowance (*Jidou Ikusei Teate*)

Monthly Allowance: ¥13500/ child

<u>Eligibility</u>: Parent or guardian whose last year's income amount meets the regulation, and raising a child who was born after April 1^{st} 1993, and the child is under any of the following conditions.

• Father or mother is deceased

- Parents are divorced
- Father or Mother has severely disability
- Parent is a single mother or a widowed mother

♦ Child Support Allowance for Handicapped Children (*Jidou Ikusei Shougai Teate*)

Monthly Allowance: ¥12500~¥15500/ child *depending on the severity of disability and household income Eligibility: Parent or guardian raising a child younger than 20 years old with physical or mental disability of disability level 1~4.

CHILD-CARE INSTITUTIONS in HAMURA

There are many authorized child-care facilities in *Hamura* for preschool age children. These facility systems are designed to answer the parents' various child-care needs flexibly. Facility location, fee and enrollment capacity vary among the facility types.

It accepts preschool age child and provides both nursery service and preschool education to the children, as well as childcare-related support to the parents and local communities. The youngest accepted age of child varies among the facilities.

♦ Ninshou Hoikujo – Tokyo Metropolitan Government(TMG)-Certified Child-Care Facility

TMG sets its own certification measures for child care facilities in Tokyo metropolitan area which aims to better cater to the specific needs in urban child rearing situation. The TMG's *Ninshou Hoikujo* qualification requirements differ from that for *Ninka Hoikujo*,(regulated by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare) in its admission capacity, admission of babies younger than 1 year old, minimum floor area, nursery fee, opening hours and so on. There are three *Ninshou Hoikujo* in *Hamura* City.

♦ Katei Fukushi-in - Home Day-care

In principal, Home Daycare is a small-sized child-care service by authorized *Katei Fukushi-in* member (licensed nursery and/or kindergarten teacher) who fulfill certain qualifications at their homes. <u>Eliqibility</u>: 8 weeks old up to 3 years old children

<u>Nursing Hours</u>: 8:30AM~5:30PM in principal (approximately 9 hours a day, except Sundays& Holidays) <u>Fee</u>: ¥33,000 per month *Meals and diapers are not included within this fee.
