# ~ How To Choose Energy Saving Products ~

You can reduce power consumption and decrease your electric bill by choosing energy saving products for your home electronics. When purchasing such products, please make sure to check whether those products have Energy Efficiency And Conservation Label on them (label sample below).

On the label, the number of stars shows the energy efficiency level of each product, and "e"-marked ball icon is in green color for products that qualify for the energy saving standard - if not qualified, the icon is in orange. The label also indicates the product's annual power consumption (年間消費電力量/kWh), and annual electricity charge (目安電気料金/円) for average usage, as well as Non-Freon Gas icon (nonフロン) for the products that has no Freon gas in its' components.

\* Non-Freon Gas icon (appears on the upper right corner of the label) is omitted for products whose structure generally do not contain Freon gas.

#### DOG REGISTRATION and RABIES SHOT

When you start having a dog in your family that are older than 91days, please register the dog to the city within 30days from the date of adoption, and have the dog receive rabies shot annually. Also, always have your dog wear a registration tag (鑑礼) and immunization tag (注射済票) on a collar.

These requirements are mandated by law, and if failed, the dog owner will be subject to legal penalty. When your dog received a rabies shot at veterinary hospital, please apply for a immunization certificate (tag) at city hall. The hospital cannot issue the tag. When the tag is lost, please apply again.

Items required for registration and immunization tag application:

- Dog Registration: ¥3000, Re-issue of registration tag ¥1600
- Immunization Certification: ¥550 and rabies shot certificate from a veterinarian or *Hamura* City

  Re-issue of Immunization Tag ¥340

#### **HOST FAMILIES WANTED for DISASTER VICTIM STUDENTS**

Hamura City would like to ask your cooperation for helping some young students who are in need of a place of Homestay to continue their education away from home town. They are elementary and junior high school students who are currently unable to live in their own homes due to *Fukushima Daiichi* Nuclear Power Plant Disaster. Host families are wanted who can provide them with safe and reliable living environment for 3 to 6 months.

Hamura City will support the school expense and school lunch fee. Other expenses related to homestay living must be provided by the host family. The students will be given counseling by school counsellors. Candidate host families need to register with the city first, which does not ensure the contract. There are certain requirements for candidate eligibility regarding home environment and financial ability.

# HAMURA CITY AIRBORNE RADIATION MONITORING in PARKS

Hamura City has conducted airborne radiation monitoring on July 7<sup>th</sup> through 14<sup>th</sup> in parks within Hamura City that are more than 1000m<sup>2</sup> in area. The results of all measurement points (at heights 5cm, 50cm, 1m) at all parks where measurements took place qualified for the safety standard.

#### SPECIFIED HEALTH CHECKUPS

We would like to remind those of you who have not yet had Specified Health Checkups (特定健康診査). The checkup ticket will expire on October 31<sup>st</sup> (Mon). The eligible *Hamura* residents are those who turn 40 years old or older in FY2011. The checkup tickets had already been mailed to them.

This medical examination program aims for the detection and treatment of lifestyle diseases, especially focusing on metabolic syndrome. Reviewing annual checkup records can help risk warning and detection of lifestyle diseases in the early stage, in which case taking medication may be avoided and treatment expense can be, sometimes dramatically, reduced.

\*High volume of appointment request is expected later in the ticket validity period. Please try to have a checkup at your earliest convenience.

- ③ Those who are not yet receiving same type of subsidy from other city

# The amount of subsidy:

Up to ¥50,000 per treatment, up to 2 times a year (for a maximum of 5 consecutive years)

<u>How to apply</u>: Please come to *Hoken* Center with a completed application form, a Certificate Of Receiving Specific Fertility Treatment (特定不妊治療受診等証明書), receipt of payment for the treatment, qualified notification issued by Tokyo (助成金交付決定通知書), your personal name stamp, and any document that indicates your bank account information.

\*On the Certificate Of Receiving Specific Fertility Treatment, the doctor's (who treated you) signature is needed. Please pick up the form at *Hoken* Center before application.
