# CHILD MEDICAL CERTIFICATE RENEWAL

乳 医療証(Infant Medical Certificate) is for the Medical Program for Babies and Preschool Children that subsidizes the medical expenses charged for medical services covered by the National Health Insurance.

子 医療証(Child Medical Certificate) is for the Medical Program for Children of Compulsory School Age that subsidizes the hospitalization expenses (excluding meal costs), and restricts the upper limit of out-patient medical charge to ¥200 at each visit (including medicine and home-visit care).

These medical certificates are renewed annually on October 1<sup>st</sup>. The new certificates will be mailed to applicable households in the late September. The expired certificates must be returned to *Kosodate Shien-ka Shien-kakari* in city hall in person or by mail.

Parents of the certificate holders are obligated to report to the city office on a fact concerning the change of medical insurance or loss of qualification for this medical program due to relocation or death.

# How to dispose of SMALL RECHARGEABLE BATTERY

Rechargeable electronic devices use small rechargeable batteries. When you dispose of such products, please do not forget to separate the small rechargeable battery. Those batteries are identifiable by recycle label on them like the samples on the right, and must be brought to a cooperating store to be processed properly. Please deposit the used rechargeable batteries into a yellow collection box (リサイクルBOX) in those stores, but never dispose of dry cell batteries into this box. They cannot be processed in a same way.

Car batteries can be collected for no fee at some auto shops and gas stations. Rechargeable batteries contain scarce resource. Please cooperate for recycling

<u>Place</u>: Hoken Center <u>Fee</u>: Free <u>Eligibility</u>: Hamura residents 40 years of age and older

\*You are not eligible to take this exam if any of the following conditions apply:

- ① Pregnant, or possibility of pregnancy ② Currently being treated for stomach or lung illness
- Those who have the same cancer screening opportunity provided by the employer

<u>Capacity</u>: 100 people each day (If there are too many applicants, selection will be done by drawing and winners will be notified by receiving a screening coupon around October 17<sup>th</sup>(Mon)).

<u>Testing Methods</u>: Abdominal X-ray for Stomach Cancer Exam, and Chest X-ray for Lung Cancer Exam How to apply: Between September  $15^{th}$ (Thu) ~ October  $5^{th}$ (Wed), fill in necessary information and:

- ①Turn it in at *Hoken* Center on weekdays, or ②Send an application post card to *Hoken* Center
- \*An application form can be obtained at *Hoken* Center, City Hall 1st floor, or City Hall branch offices. You can also download it from the City Website.
- \*This is the 2nd season of screening. The next season will be announced in December.

#### Notes:

- You may apply for all the screening/exams conducted on the same date.
- We provide sputum examination only for people with the following conditions:
- ① Those who had bloody sputum within past 6 months.
- ② Smoker who has smoked (number of cigarettes per day) x (total smoking years) = 400 or more.
