DECONTAMINATION WORK at FUJIMIDAIRA BRANCH LIBRARY

On past December 28^{th} (Wed), the city's official radiation level measurement was carried out on the ground of *Fujimidaira* Branch Library. The result then indicated that the dose rate at 5cm from ground exceeded the *Hamrua* City's safety standard limit for need of decontamination (0.23 μ sv/h). The city has taken decontamination action by removing the contaminated soil around the facility. The dose rate measured after the decontamination work lowered below the city's safety standard rate. If you wish to know more detail on this case, please feel free to contact *Kankyou Hozen-ka Kankyou Hozen-kakari*. *Hamura* City is carrying out radiation level monitoring of all municipal facilities seguentially.





CHILD REARING SUPPORT NEWS

< Vocational Training Support for Single-Mothers >

Do you know about the public support for single-mothers' vocational training? There is a public grant program to support single-mothers pay for job training and education expenses spent towards acquiring an occupational license. The job trainings subject to this grant program are for the following professions;

medical clerknursecook

home-care provider
 physical therapist
 public health nurse
 tax accountant
 nursery teacher

occupational therapist
 care worker
 barbers and cosmetologist

<u>Eligibility</u>: To apply for this grant in *Hamura* City, an applicant must be a single-mother who is raising a child(ren) of under age 20, residing in *Hamura* City, and receiving Child-rearing Allowance or her income is at the equivalent level to the said allowance recipients' income condition.

<u>Application & Inquiries</u>: Consultation with a Single-mother Independence Support Counselor is required for determining whether the vocational school the applicant is planning to enroll qualifies for this grant program of your interest. If you wish to have this consultation, or to know more about this grant program, please make an appointment with *Kosodate Shien-ka Shien-kakari*, and bring the information material of the vocational program. The consultation must take place prior to the school enrollment.

< Short-Stay Child Care Facility for Pre-School Children >

If a child needs long hour care when his/her parents have a circumstance such as illness, injury, ceremonial occasion, nursing of a family member, or business trip, the child can be looked after at Tokyo *Keimei Gakuen, located* in $\bar{O}me$ City, for up to 7 days.
