#### **RABIES SHOT for YOUR DOG**

Dog Registration and Rabies Vaccination for pet dogs are obligated to dog owners by law. Owners must register their dog(s) to their resident municipality and ensure their dog(s) receive Rabies Shots annually. This year's Rabies Vaccination Form (狂犬病予防注射済票交付申請書, pale-blue paper) was mailed to registered dog owners in March. Please be sure to bring the form when coming to the vaccination site.

- Please make sure to arrive at the vaccination site on time.
- If your dog is ill or pregnant, please consult with a veterinarian before getting a rabies shot.
- If your dog is under 3 months old, or has bitten anyone within 2 weeks, it is not eligible for the shot.
- Dogs must be brought to the sites by adults who are able to control them well.
- To prevent troubles, please make sure that dog's collar is secure and tighten the leash at the shot sites.
- Please make sure your dog is clean. Also do not forget to take your dog's droppings home!

Fees: Registered dog... ¥3,550 (¥3,000 for shot, ¥550 for shot certificate tag).

Non-registered dog... ¥6,550 (¥3,000 for registration, ¥3,000 for shot, ¥550 for shot certificate tag) Registration and Rabies Vaccination:

- Dog Registration must be done within 30 days after you obtain a dog, or in the case of new-born puppies, register them within 90 days from the date of birth.
- Dogs must receive rabies shot between April and June every year.
- The first year you own a dog that is older than 91 days, the shot must be given within 30 days.

# ~ Let's Think About What Is Important About Having Pets ~

Based on the Act on Welfare and Management of Animals, the following rules are stated:

# ■ Love your pet and keep him/her in your family through its lifetime

Every pet owner has a responsibility to take care of a pet for its entire life time, as well as to fully understand the pet's habits and nature.

# ■ Sterilization/Castration of your Pet

If you do not wish for your pets to have babies, Sterilization/Castration is highly recommended. Not only will your pet's personality calm down, but it also prevents reproductive system diseases.

# ■ ID Tags for your Pet

There are many pet animals that get lost and are unable to find their way home by itself. Please make sure to put an ID Tag on your pet, along with the immunization certificate tag.

# ■ Use a leash when taking your dog for a walk

When taking your dog for a walk, keep your dog leashed.

# ■ Be responsible of your dog's "Deposits"

When taking your dog for a walk and your dog potties, wash the area with water.

Also take the dog's "deposit" back to your home and dispose of it properly. As of July 1<sup>st</sup>(Sun), doing so will be the owner's obligation (As of October 1<sup>st</sup>(Mon), there will be a fine of no more than ¥5,000).

#### Penalties

For those who did not have your dog get a rabies shot, or not having a Dog Registration/Rabies Shot Tag attached to the dog, the owner will be fined up to ¥200,000. Getting fined by not obeying the regulation is a crime. Depending on the situation, in addition to the fine, you may be arrested.

#### SUBSIDY for FOOD WASTE COMPOST BUCKET

As a public program to promote Food Waste Reduction, *Hamura* City will provide partial subsidy for purchasing a food waste decomposing container available at general market for domestic use.

Applicant Eligibility: Hamura residents who purchased a qualifying item after April 1st for use at home.

<u>Equipment Qualification</u>: a container which is designed to use no electricity that holds food waste being decomposed in it by micro-organism activity.

Subsidy Amount: 50% of the purchase price, or ¥10,000 maximum. \*¥100 and less is rounded-down.

# < Japanese Encephalitis Vaccine>

Japanese Government will resume encouraging the Japanese Encephalitis vaccine for young children due to adopting the new type vaccine with reduced risk of side effects. Parent of a child who turns following ages in FY2012 will receive Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination Form (日本脳炎予防接種予診票).

\* The enclosed 3 forms are for 1st, 2nd and 3rd shot for the Vaccination First Phase (第一期).

**For 3 year olds:** Parents will receive a Notification of Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination and the forms along with the regular 3-year health check-up notification.

**For 8 & 9 year olds:** Parents will receive the notification in the child's birth month. If your child has already taken the same vaccine, please disregard the notification.

<u>Other Age</u>: Children and youth who were born between June 1<sup>st</sup> 1995 ~ April 1<sup>st</sup> 2007 are eligible for public subsidy for Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination Fee (both First and Second Phases) any time until 2 days prior to the birthday turning age 20. If your child is not 3, 8, 9 years old this year but is applicable to age eligibility, you can obtain a vaccination form at *Hoken* Center with presentation of Maternal and Child Health Handbook.

Subsidy Eligibility: Hamura residents who are 2 months old ~ 4 years old
