#### ELECTRIC POWER SAVING for SUMMER 2013

#### ~ Everyone's Cooperation Needed! ~

Following the suspension of power production at nuclear power plants throughout Japan, the serious shortage of electric power supply is expected during summer. In order to secure stable power supply and to avoid a black out, everyone in Japan is asked to cooperate in the reduction of electricity usage. Inquiries: *Kankyou Hozen-ka Kankyou Hozen-kakari* 

#### ~ Keep-Cool Eco Ideas to deal with Summer Heat ~

#### ✤ Uchimizu (sprinkling water on the ground)

Sprinkle water on the ground and pavement around your house. When that water evaporates, it takes away some heat with it. Reuse remaining bath tub water for this to save the water cost and power usage. The best times for *Uchimizu* are in the early morning and in the early evening.

#### ✤ Green Curtain

Grow climber plants in front of a window. When the vines reach higher and the leaves block the sunlight, this curtain will help keep the room temperature lower than outdoor temperature.

#### ✤ Sudare (window screen)

A *Sudare* screen blocks the direct sunlight and let breeze through at the same time. Natural material, such as reed and bamboo, tends to be less heated by sunlight than manmade material. Hang them or let them stand right outside of your window to block the heat from coming into the room.

*Uchiwa* and *Sensu* are potable and very handy fan. In addition to the cool-keeping ideas introduced above, a Fuurin (wind-charm) has been a long desired summer item in Japanese tradition, which, with its pleasant sound, is thought to give you mental effect of coolness. Shopping for your favorite one is very much fun!

#### Benefit of Seasonal Food for Your Body \*

Summer crops and in-season catch of fish have effects to cool down body temperature when eaten.

#### Street Rules for Keeping Safe and Pleasant Streets for Everyone

- When you ride a bicycle on a sidewalk, be careful with pedestrians and don't speed up too much.
- Do not set up banners, signboards or display products on streets without a permission based on Road Law.
- Do not leave bicycles and motor bicycles illegally parked on streets.
- $\cdot$  Leaving ramp blocks (at parking space entrance/exit) on a street is prohibited.
- Do not dispose of trash or grease into street gutter.

 $\cdot\,$  Do not neglect garden branches growing out over fence into street obstructing safety on the street.

There are public bicycle parking lots (駐輪場) managed by *Hamura* City, located near JR *Hamura* Station and *Ozaku* Station. Bicycles are allowed parking at any of these lots. Motorized bicycles (原動機付自転車) of 50cc or less displacement are allowed parking only at *Hamura-eki Nishiguchi Dai-san* (羽村駅西口第 3), *Ozaku-eki Higashiguchi Dai-ichi* (小作駅東口第1), *Nishiguchi Dai-ichi* (西年1) and *Nishiguchi Dai-ni* (西口第 2) parking lots.

Child-Rearing Allowance (*Jidou Fuyou Teate*) is provided to households of single parent. The allowance is provided to qualifying household until the first March that comes after the child turns 18 years old. (If the child has a handicap certification with grade 1~3, the allowance is provided until he/she is at 19.) <u>Monthly Allowance</u>: First child ¥9,780~¥41,430 (determined according to the household income),

Second child ¥5,000, Third child and younger ¥3,000 per additional child <u>Eligibility</u>: The applicant's (parent) child meets any of the following conditions (1)~(5), and must not be under any of the disqualifying conditions  $1\sim$ 6.

(1) Parents are divorced(2) Father or mother is deceased(3) Father or Mother has severe disability(4) Death or survival of father or mother cannot be confirmed

(5) Other (duty to support is neglected over one year by a parent, or a parent is imprisoned over one year, etc.)

- (1) The child is living in a child care institution (2) The child is receiving any public pension support
- ③ The parent is receiving any public pension excluding Old-age Welfare Pension (*Rourei Fukushi Nenkin*)
- 4 The parent or the child does not have a residential address in Japan
- (5) The household income of the preceding year exceeded the qualified income level
- 6 The parent living with the child is in a de facto relationship (common-law marriage).
