- O Temporary collecting hours are different from regular routine collecting hours.
- To take out plastic containers, please wash them and place them in clear/half clear trash bags.
- O When detaching metal from calendars and paper is stuck inside of the metal piece, you may dispose the stuck paper along with the metal.

#### < Spot-Collection: How to dispose of Pet Bottles, White Trays, and Paper Packs >

December 29<sup>th</sup>(Sat) will be the last day to dispose of this trash before the New Year. The spot-collection container will be closed and locked on December 30<sup>th</sup>, and will be re-opened on January 4<sup>th</sup>, after 8AM.

#### < Excreta Collection >

The last day for Excreta Collection before New Year is December 28<sup>th</sup>(Fri). If you wish to have this service on the 28<sup>th</sup>, please make an appointment at Excreta Collection Center (\$\alpha\$570-7733) by 27<sup>th</sup>(Thu), 3:30PM.

\*Any appointment made later than this time will be served in January, starting on the 4<sup>th</sup>(Fri).

#### CAUTIONS for WASTE DISPOSAL TOWARDS THE END OF THE YEAR

In Japan, there is an end-of-the-year cleaning custom called "*Oo-Souji*". In this custom, people tend to do extensive house/office cleaning. By the influence of this custom, *Hamura* Recycle Center will see the busiest time of a year in December, and also the city waste collection schedule will be adjusted.

If you are planning to take out oversized trash, please plan ahead and take action at your earliest chance. Also, when you dispose of items of a kind that you rarely take out, please check the disposal rules of them.

#### **HOW TO DISPOSE OF FABRIC GOODS**

Please do not put out fabrics for collection on rainy days. Wet fabrics can not be accepted.

#### \*Thick blankets, bedding linens and curtains

Feather/Down-filled beddings cannot be recycled. Please dispose of them as oversized trash.

Other large fabric items have to be folded and bundled tightly, then put out for Recyclable A collection.

#### **\*Un-recyclable Fabric Goods**

Only heavily soiled garments cannot be recycled. When you discard such items as burnable trash, please attach a note written " $\sharp \, \exists \, h \, b \, \mathcal{O}$ " (soiled) onto the trash bag for an indication of correct disposal.

Floor mats that measure more than 50cm in flattened state, regardless of its' material and condition, have to be disposed as burnable trash or oversized trash. If it is cut into pieces less than 50cm each, it can be disposed in a burnable waste bag, otherwise, it is an oversized trash even as rolled up or folded.

#### HOW TO DISPOSE OF OVERSIZED TRASH

#### ■ Home Collection by appointment

Simply call Sodaigomi Uketsuke Center and make a pick-up appointment 2570-7733.

Collection requests are accepted until December 28<sup>th</sup>(Fri), however, the collection is not guaranteed to happen before the end of year. \*Collection request received on 28<sup>th</sup> will be scheduled after the New Year holidays.

#### ■ Carry-in Collection

You may bring the items directly to the Recycle Center. December is a very busy time for oversized trash collection and recycling. Please plan ahead.

Recycle Center's final service day of 2012 will be December 28<sup>th</sup>(Fri), open until 4PM.

The Center will reopen at 9AM, January 4<sup>th</sup>(Fri) 2013. \*The Recycle Center will be open on January 6<sup>th</sup>(Sun).

\*Oversized trash sticker is not required for carry-in collection, however, the handling fee will be charged at Recycle Center (¥20 per Kg, minimum of 5kg=¥100).

#### \* What is "Oversized Trash"

In principal, an oversized trash measures 50cm or more at its' longest side. However, items that cannot be processed (crushed) with machinery are considered oversized trash, even if they measure less than 50cm. Examples of such items are listed on the bottom-half part of *Hamura* Trash Recycling Manual page 36. Some small home appliances that measure less than 50cm, such as video decks, electric heaters, rice cookers, vacuum cleaners and etc., are often mistaken as oversized trash. These appliances, as well as umbrellas, can be disposed as non-burnable trash.

# \* Electric appliances that need to be processed by manufacturers

Under the Electric Appliance Recycling Law, televisions, refrigerators, freezers, washing/drying machines, air conditioners cannot be processed by the city. Consumer must pay the designated recycling fee specified by appliance category (same in any disposal method), and follow any of the following disposal methods;

- Ask the shop where you purchased the appliance to take it with fee.
- Ask the shop where you are purchasing the item's replacement to take it with fee.
- Pay for the fee at Postal Bank or Post Office and receive Kaden Risaikuru-ken, then transport the item by;
  - · Using home pick-up service, or take the item to the intermediate waste collection site
    - → Contact *Marujun Shouji* \$\alpha 554-2229, 9AM~5PM, weekdays only (pick-up/transport fee charged)
  - Taking the item by yourself to the manufacturer's handling station  $\rightarrow$  Contact the item's manufacturer.

# Tokyo Metropolitan Campaign ! STOP TAX ARREARS ACCUMULATIONS!

Tokyo metropolitan government designates December for a month of the Tax Arrears Recovery Campaign. At this opportunity *Hamura* City will enhance its' efforts in recovering taxes in arrears, because it recognizes the importance of stability of tax income and of ensuring the fairness in tax obligation for all tax payers. *Hamura* City acts on a serious delinquency cases with forcible measures, for instance, by placing attachment on a delinquent's properties (salary, real estates, fixed assets, savings) and recover the tax in arrears directly from their monetary assets or from the proceedings from selling the seized properties at a public auction. If you are having financial difficulty with paying taxes.... Please do not hesitate to consult us about your financial problems; lost job, low income, being out of country for long period, etc. We would like to know the reason for tax delinquency so we can assist you.

#### AUTOMOBILE TAX REDUCTION for PEOPLE WITH DISABILITY

Those who hold a Physical Disability Certificate, a Certificate for Adults and Children with Mental Deficiency, Health and Welfare Handbook for Mentally Disabled, or Certificate for The War Disabled, with disability of a kind that meets a qualification for this benefit can apply for the reduction of Automobile Tax and Automobile Acquisition Tax. \*There is a maximum amount set for the reduction rate.

If the above condition applies to you, you may file an application before the end of May 2013 for the tax reduction in FY2013. The application for Automobile Tax Reduction needs be, in principal, filed within one month from the date of vehicle registration in order for the reduction to be applied in the year of acquisition.

#### WATER PIPE MAINTENANCE TIPS for WINTER SEASON

#### < Water Leakage >

In an residential unit, residents are liable for the maintenance of service pipes and water usage meter. It is highly recommended to check for water leakage periodically. If the meter keeps running when you are not using water, or the surrounding area of the water meter is always wet, please contact the Waterworks Department or a certified plumber for professional inspection and repair work.

#### < Pipe & Water Meter Protection Measures in Winter >

During the mid-winter time, water pipes and water meters may get damaged from severe coldness. In order to prevent such damages, it is strongly recommended to take measures; for instance, wrap the water pipes where you can to give it insulation, and put some insulation material like styrene foam pieces in a meter box. # HOW TO DISPOSE OF GRASS, LEAVES and TREE BRANCHES

Grass, leaves and tree branches collected from private property can be taken out for a regular Burnable Waste Collection without charge if disposed properly in compliance with the following rules.

- \*Tree branches please bind branches having a length of 50cm or less and a diameter of 10cm or less into bundles of no more than 30cm in diameter.
- \*Grass/Leaves please put into transparent or translucent bags with a capacity of 45 liters or less.

  Sand and stones should be excluded as much as possible.
- \*Up to 6 bundles or bags (combined) of branches or grass/leaves will be accepted in one collection day.
- \*Wood components from furniture or interior goods, broken-down lumber, and other wood products cannot be collected by the city for free of charge. If such pieces are less than 50cm long, please dispose of them in city-designated burnable waste bags, otherwise, dispose of them as oversized trash.
- \*Plant garbage from private garden or farm has to be disposed in city-designated burnable waste bag. Inquiry: Seikatsu Kankyou-ka Seikatsu Kankyou-kakari Ext.204
