CHILD MEDICAL CERTIFICATE RENEWAL

㊦ 医療証(Infant Medical Certificate) is for the "Medical Program for Babies and Preschool Children" that subsidizes the medical expenses charged for medical services covered by the National Health Insurance.

㊧ 医療証(Child Medical Certificate) is for the "Medical Program for Children of Compulsory School Age" that subsidizes the hospitalization expenses (excluding meal costs), and restricts the upper limit of out-patient medical charge to ¥200 at each visit (including medicines and home-visit care).

These medical certificates are renewed annually on October 1st. The new certificates will be mailed to applicable households in the late September. The current certificates will expire on September 30th(Mon). After expiration, it must be returned to *Kosodate Shien-ka Shien-kakari* in city hall in person or by mail.

Parents of the certificate holders are obligated to report to the city office on a fact concerning the change of medical insurance or loss of qualification for this medical program due to relocation or other matters.

< **"Fuiku-shou" (Habitual Abortion/Recurrent Miscarriage)** >

The term Habitual Abortion, also known as Recurrent Miscarriage, is not yet commonly known. It is the frequent occurrence of pregnancies that end in miscarriage of the fetus. Normally about 10 ~ 15% of pregnancies end up as a natural abortion, however, most of those cases are caused by the fetus rather than mother, and those mothers deliver babies with no problem in the next pregnancy. If natural abortion occurs to you repeatedly, please see a doctor for an examination to help identify the cause. There are also non-profit associations available to answer questions regarding this medical problem.
