< Waterworks Promotion Week - June 1st ~ 7th Annually >

The week of June 1st ~ 7th is the Waterworks Promotion Week. During this week, the Hamura City Waterworks Department will welcome visitors to the tour in the *Haisuitou*(Standpipe) and the *Jousuijou*(Filtration Plant). These major facilities will be open to the public to promote the understanding of our water system that local residents rely on for daily water supply, which is sourced in groundwater in Hamura City.

The Waterworks Department is, along with the wide range of responsibilities, currently carrying out the earthquake-resistance improvement project for the underground pipe systems as well as the regular monitoring of local water quality focusing on the detection of radio-active substances in order to maintain quality water supply. It is not necessary to make an appointment in advance to join the tours.

Haisuitou (Standpipe): Open to public on June 1st(Sun) ~ 7th(Sat) 9AM ~ 4PM.

From the top of the tower, you can enjoy the grand view of the Hamura city landscape!

Jousuijou (Filtration Plant): Open to public on June 1st(Sun) and 7th(Sat), 9AM~4PM.

This plant is equipped with a membrane water filtration system of the largest scale in Japan.

< Colon Cancer Screening >

Date: June 2nd(Mon) ~ October 31st(Fri) Testing Methods: Testing stool for occult blood (for 2 days)

Fee: Free Eligibility: *Hamura* residents who are age 40 or older as of the examination date

*To those who turned 40, 45, 50, 55, or 60 years old last fiscal year, *Hamura* city has sent out coupons for colon cancer screening. If you have one, please also bring the coupon when taking an examination.

< Bone Density Test for Women >

Women's Bone Density generally starts decreasing after 20's, and especially around the menopause.

All female residents are encouraged to take this chance and check their bone condition for the prevention of Osteoporosis (Brittle-bone Disease), a very common bone disease among women.

Fee: Free Eligibility: Female *Hamura* Residents of age 20 to 64 years as of July 13th.

*Those who are being treated for Osteoporosis, pregnant or have a possibility of being pregnant cannot apply.

Capacity: First 50 people per time (If more applies, it will be chosen by lottery)

< Coupons for Free Screenings for Female-specific Cancers >

Hamura City will provide coupons (subsidy certificate) for free cancer screening for Cervical or Breast Cancer to female residents who did not use the coupons previously provided between FY2009 and FY2012.

Cervical cancer screening coupons will also be issued for female residents turning age 20, and Breast Cancer screening coupons for female residents turning age 40 in FY2014. The new coupon will be mailed to the applicable residents in late May. It can be used by the addressee starting from June 2nd.

• Breast Cancer screening coupon (乳がん検診無料クーポン券) expires on December 26th 2014.

• Cervical cancer screening coupon (子宮頸がん検診無料クーポン券) expires on February 27th 2015.

*It is recommended to be tested in June ~ September. Making a test appointment is expected to become increasingly difficult after October. Inquiry: Hoken Center (city hall ext.627)

< Breast Cancer Screening >

Date: By appointment between June 2nd(Mon) ~ September 30th(Tue)

Participating Medical Facilities: Fussa Hospital or Nishimura Iin *both located in Fussa City

Fee: ¥1,600 *Please pay at the Hospital on examination day

*No fee for Welfare Recipients. Please bring the Certificate of Welfare Recipient.

Eligibility: Female residents at age 40 or older as of the examination day who were not tested last fiscal year.

Examination Detail: Health interview, clinical breast examination, and mammography screening (X-ray)

How to apply: Starting from May 21st(Wed), please call or visit Hoken Center first and obtain a Certificate for Breast Cancer Subsidy. Then make an appointment with medical facility.

< Uterine Cancer Screening >

Date: By appointment between June 2nd(Mon) ~ September 30th(Tue) Fee: Free

Participating Medical Facilities: Yorimitsu Ladies Clinic (Hamura), Fussa Hospital and Taisei Hospital (Fussa)

Eligibility: Female residents at age 20 or older as of the examination day who were not tested last fiscal year.

How to apply: The procedure is same as the Breast Cancer Screening Application.

Notes about Breast / Uterine Cancer Screenings :

- These subsidy certificates are available in limited number. Please apply as early as you can.
- It will take about a month for the result reports of tests taken through this subsidy program. If you are already having symptoms, please make a doctor appointment on your own.

< Rubella(Fuushinn) Immunization for Adults >

Rubella, also known as German Measles, is becoming ever more prevalent among adults in recent years.

For expectant mothers, contracting rubella poses a threat to cause her fetus to be born with congenital rubella syndrome which is characterized by hearing impairments, cardiac disease or cataracts.

Of Japanese people, today's men in their 20's to 40's are particularly vulnerable to this viral disease because they are the generation who were not inoculated with rubella vaccine as part of their childhood routine immunization. Hamura City is now encouraging everyone to receive Measles-Rubella immunization if not certain whether you have been vaccinated.

*** Woman who is pregnant or having possibility of being pregnant should not get Rubella or MR vaccination. The vaccine could lead to the fetus developing a disorder. Women also should not get pregnant for two months after receiving Rubella vaccination for the same reason.**

Route of Infection, Symptoms

Outbreaks of rubella usually occur from spring to early summer. Rubella virus is transmitted by respiratory route such as coughing and sneezing. The major symptoms are high fever, rashes and swollen lymph glands. During the first week of rashes start appearing, the chance of spreading the virus is at the highest. Rubella patients are strongly advised to avoid having contacts with people during this period unless it is necessary.

Subsidy Amount: The immunization fee may vary by institution. *Hamura* City provides ¥5000 for Measles-Rubella combination immunization and ¥3000 for Rubella-only immunization received before the end of program period; March 31st(Tue) 2015. The balance must be paid by an individual.

Eligibility: Female *Hamura* residents at age 19 or older who wish to be pregnant in the future, whose Rubella antibody titer is proven low by a test. *If you have never taken the test before, it can be provided for free.

Application and Appointment:

In order to have a subsidy applied to your immunization charge, you have to first apply for the subsidy at *Hoken* Center and be issued a subsidy certificate, then make a vaccination appointment at medical facility participating in this program. PUBLIC SERVICE & ADMINISTRATION

< Application for Child Support Allowance >

Child Support Allowance (*Jidou Ikusei Teate*) is provided mainly to single parent households which meet the income limit requirement. Children of such households are eligible to receive this benefit until the first March following his/her 18th birthday. Children in foster care facilities are excluded from eligibility. There are two types of this allowance; general allowance and disability allowance. To find out about qualification requirements and/or application procedure, please contact *Kosodate Shien-ka* at city hall ext.237.

June is the beginning month of a fiscal year for Child Support Allowance Program. If your household meets the qualification and wish to apply for the 2014 program, please file an application by the end of May.

❖ Current beneficiaries will receive Notification of Current Status (現況届用紙) by mail in June. Please fill-in the form and be sure to submit it by the deadline stated on the form.

◆ Child Support Allowance (*Jidou Ikusei Teate*)

Allowance Amount: ¥13,500 per child, monthly

Eligibility: Household of a parent/guardian with child(ren) who turns 18 year old or younger in FY2014, meets the income limit requirement (previous year's income) and in any of the following conditions.

- Parents are divorced
- Father or mother was deceased
- Child was born out of wedlock
- Parent has severe disability that prevents him/her to be employed (issued with a mental disability certificate *Ai no Techou* grade 1~3 or physical disability certificate *Shintai Shogaisha Techou* grade 1~2)

Item needed for application: Applicant and child(ren)'s *Kosekitouhon*(official copy of family register), Applicant's bank book, disability certificate if own one, *Inkan*

◆ Special Child Support Allowance for Handicapped Children (*Jidou Ikusei Shougai Teate*)

Allowance Amount: ¥12,500~¥15,500 per child, monthly *depending on the disability and household income

Eligibility: Household of a parent/guardian with child(ren) under 20 years old with disability certified by mental disability certificate grade 1~4 or (*Shintai Shogaisha Techou*) grade 1~4.

Items needed for application: Applicant's bank book, disability certificate, *Inkan*

Notes: If you have not lived in *Hamura* on Jan 1st,2014, you must bring the *Shotoku Shoumeisho*(income certificate) or *Kazei/Hikazei Shoumeisho*(tax declaration certificate) which states your income of 2013 issued by the municipality office of where you lived then. Other documents may be needed according to the condition. Please inquire for more details.

< Warning to All Parents Having Small Children >

In past March, a very tragic incident happened in *Saitama* prefecture involving a death of 2-year-old boy, which happened while he was under care of a babysitter. The boy was found dead in an apartment of the babysitter who was uncertified but entrusted with the boy and his brother through an online babysitting service mediator. Mother of the victimized boy was unaware who her babysitter was on that day. In order to prevent the recurrence of such tragic incidents, parents who need to use babysitting service are strongly advised to follow these guidelines;

~ Security Guidelines for Using Babysitter Service ~

- ① Carefully research about the service provider before you contract
- ② Do not skip the face-to-face interview procedure before deciding on a babysitter
- ③ Confirm the accuracy of service provider's business registration information
- ④ Confirm the location and environment of place where your children will be staying
- ⑤ If the babysitter says he/she is an certified care provider, make sure of the certificate authenticity
- ⑥ Make sure that the babysitter is covered by insurance policy for job related incidences
- ⑦ Contact the babysitter periodically during the service to check on the circumstance
- ⑧ Be prepared with emergency communication by sharing a swift contact methods with the babysitter
- ⑨ Have the babysitter give you detailed report when you pick up your child(ren)
- ⑩ If you have any complaints on the conducts of babysitter or the service system, do not delay to consult the service provider's office

< Tokyo Hikikomori Support Net >

If you are having concerns on your child who is in "*Hikikomori*" state, withdrawal mental state, Tokyo *Hikikomori* Support Net is one of the places you can turn to for help. Their consultants will support you through phone or email-based consultations, or by home-visits if necessary.
