Public Certification Service For Individuals is a system for electronic verification of individual. By a thorough confirmation of the individual's identity at a municipal office, an IC certificate card is issued with 3-year validity and issuance fee of ¥500. The card is encoded with the holder's information, and it allows an access to online administrative procedures, such as tax return filing, property deeds application, etc. The system is currently in effect in the municipal office network and in the services of most of government agencies.

## NATIONAL PENSION (*KOKUMIN NENKIN*) PROGRAM ENROLLMENT

The National Pension (*Kokumin Nenkin*) is a social security system operated by the national government in which everyone in applicable age pays into a financial pool of insurance premiums. It is mostly in preparation for life after retirement from work, but the system will also provide financial support to the insured persons in case of becoming handicapped, or to the dependent family in case of death of the insured person.

Any residents in Japan who are at age 20 to 60 years old, regardless of nationality, must enroll in National Pension, unless they are already enrolled in Welfare Annuity (*Kousei Nenkin*) or a Mutual Aid Association Pension Plan (*Kyousai Kumiai Nenkin*) through the benefit provided at their place of employment.

\*Spouses of members of the said other pension plans are not obligated to enroll in National Pension.

If you are at applicable age and living in Japan, but not enrolled in any public pension plans in Japan, please come to city hall for a consultation to know the necessary procedures.

National Pension Brochure and Enrollment Application will be mailed to the residents who will turn 20 years old this year. Please fill in and submit the completed form to *Hoken Nenkin-ka*.

## TAX FILING for FIXED PROPERTY

If you have a registered property demolished within the year of 2014, please file a Lost Property Registration (*Messhitsu Touki*). In a case of demolishing an unregistered property, please also file a report. In case of failing to file the report, property tax will continue to be levied.

#### ▶ Registration of Land Use

If you had any of the following cases in 2014 regarding your land property, please file a required report.

- Shifted the use purpose (residential/commercial) of land property due to building a new house
- Had existing house demolished, and changed the use purpose of land property.
- Built a business property within the (former) residential land property
- Changed a residential real estate to a commercial space

Deadline is January 31<sup>st</sup>(Fri).

#### ▶ Special Measures for Rebuilding on Residential Property

\* If a residential building was demolished before the property tax assessment base date (January 1<sup>st</sup>) and the works on building a new residential building had already started on the site, the land can be assessed for taxation under residential use upon verification of certain requirements.

### < Houterasu Japan Legal Support Center \*Consultation Available in Foreign Languages\* >

*Houterasu* Japan legal support Center, as known as JLSC, is a legal information center established under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Justice. It works with clients for establishing a legal paths to the solution, or refer them to pertinent organizations that offer a more specialized service. The JLSC is open to anyone and will hear inquiries about legal issues concerning Debt, Divorce, Work, Accident or others.

JLSC also offers free interpretation service for legal consultations. The supported languages are English, Chinese, Portuguese, Spanish and Tagalog. Interpretation service is not available over phone consultations.

Interpretation service is provided in the following method;

- ① When a client is in the office for a consultation, the legal advisor calls an "Over-the-phone Interpreter"
- ② What client says to the interpreter will be relayed to the advisor in Japanese.
- ③ The advisor will tell a response to the interpreter in Japanese.
- ④ The interpreter will translate the response and relay it to the client.

The JLSC also provides various aids to citizens with financial difficulties such as providing free professional legal consultation and advancing fees for attorneys and judicial scriveners. (\*Screening is required)

If your child has not been vaccinated with DPT and Polio up to this time, from now on you will be administered the DTPP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, and Polio Vaccine (inactivated poliovirus vaccine), due to the fact that DPT (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus) Vaccine is hard to obtain. Some cases will not allow the immediate administering of shots due to waiting periods after previous shots. The pre-immunization questionnaire sheet for DPT can be exchanged with one which will enable registration at medical facility to receive DTPP.
