< Tax Exemption for Purchased Pharmaceuticals ~ Switch OTC Drugs > Kazei ka, ≅Ext. 162 As of January 1st, 2017 lasting till December 31st, 2021, a tax exemption for purchase of pharmaceutical products is offered to households that purchase non-prescription drugs for the total annual amount exceeding ¥12,000 (total ¥88,000 limit per household). This policy will go into effect in the income tax for 2017 or the municipal inhabitant tax for 2018.

Switch OTC Pharmaceutical Products (over the counter): cold medicine medicine for indigestion medicine for runny nose athlete's food remedy ringworm medication medication for stiff shoulder, back pain, and arthritis (poultice/ pad)

The exemption cannot be claimed along with the other medical exemptions. To be certified you must qualify under standards such as being aware of health exerting an example of disease prevention by going to

check-ups, etc.

The National Pension (*Kokumin Nenkin*) is a social security system operated by the national government in which everyone in applicable age pays into a financial pool of insurance premiums. Any residents in Japan who are at age 20 to 60 years old, regardless of nationality, must enroll in National Pension, If you reside overseas, you can make procedures for enrollment.

National Pension Brochure and Enrollment Application will be mailed to the residents who will turn 20 years old this year. Please fill in and submit the completed form to the *Shimin-ka, Kourei Iryou · Nenkin-kakari* located on the 1st floor.

If you are at applicable age and living in Japan, but not enrolled in any public pension plans in Japan, please come to city hall for a consultation to know the necessary procedures.

< Revisions for the Resident Tax System Effective Starting Fiscal Year 2017 >

The Resident Tax System will be revised from fiscal year 2017 for registered citizens of each municipality. The Municipal Inhabitants' Tax will be affected by this revision.

*You must have your individual number card or number notification card / certified copy of resident register along with sufficient identification to complete procedures of tax exemption.

~ Changes in applicable annual income amount for deductions (Income Bracket) ~

If a citizen's annual income exceeds ¥12 million yen, the amount of 2.3 million yen is the maximum which can be claimed as a tax deduction from annual income.

(A tax exempt amount is sum which is excluded from total earnings of annual income.)

(The amount of tax withheld (天引き) from the income by the employer (or filing a tax return if not withheld) is subject to change due to this.)

~ Official documentation required for personal spousal exemptions for relatives residing overseas ~ Those filing for various dependent deductions (扶養控除)(dependent, spousal, special spousal, person with disability) in the income tax return (*kakutei shinkoku*) of 2016 and applicable to the metropolitan inhabitants' tax / municipal inhabitants' tax of 2017 should either present or submit supporting official documentation. The tax payer claiming a dependent deduction should prepare proof of one's relationship with the family member (including deductions for those under age 16), and also the financial records such as overseas remittance pertaining to the relative who lives overseas. If the tax payer has proven legitimacy by providing the said documents to employer (withholding agent), in relation to withholding tax from income or pension or when filing for annual tax return, this requirement does not apply.

Documents Providing Proof of Kinship applicable to ① or ② and an accurate translation should be provided as well. ① Documents issued by state or public organization such as family register under registered domicile or passport of the relative being supported that lives overseas. ② Documents issued by state or public organization with name, date of birth, official residential address, such as family register, birth certificate, or marriage certificate.

Financial Documents applicable to ① or ② proving bank remittance supporting the dependent living overseas in providing financial resources for dwelling / education and an accurate translation should be provided as well. ①A record of bank remittance issued when tax payer in Japan sent money to the relative living overseas, issued by the financial institution that handled it. ② Statements issued by the credit card finance corporation showing the active use of credit card by the relative residing overseas. These statements must prove that purchased items by the dependent are funded by the tax payer's financial resources.

~ A one year extension > Green Qualified Vehicle Tax Alleviation Measure ~

"Green Qualified Low Emission Vehicle" owners are eligible for a reduced tax burden for taxes paid in 2017, if you purchased a vehicle between April 1st, 2016 ~ March 31st, 2017 for which initial registration was made (The vehicle must not be one that has been already registered before).

Do you know about Welfare Volunteers (*Minsei Iin*) and Child Welfare Volunteers (*Jidou Iin*)? They are authorized private volunteers commissioned by the Minister for Health and Welfare to conduct private voluntary welfare activities including:

- Cooperating with public organizations such as municipal welfare offices to coordinate the public assistance-related administrative works.
- Working in coordination with the administrative office of city facilities and public organizations.
- Providing investigation reports on a household applying for the certification of social insurance or public assistance when requested by a public administrative office.
 - *The permitted field of investigation is restricted for privacy protection purposes.
- Making friendly visit for counseling at homes of elderly people living alone and residents needing guidance
- Participating in various local meetings and events.

Residents are welcome to consult the welfare volunteers of their residence district on matters concerning daily life, or for an initial advice on other issues. You can find the contact information of your area's welfare volunteer below. (some districts pending selection for the moment)

*All welfare volunteers except the chief child welfare volunteers are concurrently commissioned as *Minsei Iin* and *Jidou Iin*, accepting consultations on matters concerning both adults and children.
