Do You Know "DV"?

Once they have become the victim's partner, they become very dominant, and can keep a watch on them with vengeance, and are abusive. "Dating DV" is domestic violence which can happen to dating couples. A certain violent behavior is expressed to the partner in a relationship. The perpetrator will hit, kick, and also make insults to humiliate the victim in public, inflict emotional violence constantly or deprive the victim of their money. This kind of inappropriate behavior is considered to be a violation of human rights, and the abuser can be tried as a criminal if they inflict serious damage.

< Be Aware of "Photochemical Smog Warning" >

Photochemical Smog is an air pollution derived from sunlight-induced chemical reaction of elements contained in vehicular emission and industrial fumes output into the atmosphere. It occurs during a hot season, on a day of sunny or hazy weather combined with minimum air current.

Hamura City issues Photochemical Smog Warning as needed. When the warning is released, a signboard "光化学スモッグ注意報発令中" will be posted at some of the city public facilities, and schools and children's facilities will be alerted.

"Green Qualified Low Emission Vehicle" owners can be eligible for the alleviated tax under the "Green Vehicle Special Provision" small light motor vehicles if you purchase a vehicle between April 1st, 2017 ~ March 31st, 2019 for which initial registration was made (The vehicle must not be one that has been already registered before).

< Tokyo Olympic / Paralympic Games Update >

Some of the features of the Paralympics are not known to most. The Paralympics Games is a sports competition held every 4 years with the Olympic Games for persons with physical disabilities.

The history of the Paralympic Games dates back to 1948 when a physician in London organized an archery competition as part of their rehabilitation program. Later, the event became an international wheelchair competition.

This expanded to become the Paralympics; the "parallel Olympics", or "the other Olympics", and "Paralympics" has now become the official term form this competition. It is exciting to watch as the level of performance advances with each Olympic Event held.

These games are designed to offer fair chances to athletes who bear disability by adjusting the rules and equipment used to gain the best performance of the athlete.

We must be aware in the society of the many obstacles faced by the disabled, and it must be known that all are equal. Sports played by the Paralympic team members are special because they have enhanced their skills by using what functions are available by hard work and perseverance.

Paralympic Games will be held from August 25th (Tue) ~ September 6th (Sun), 2020.

< Protruding Objects such as Limbs and Branches are Very Dangerous >

Mirrors and signs on sidewalks and roadways are sometimes covered by overgrown trees and plants, and can disturb traffic. Signs on the side of the road can narrow the width, and in some cases causes tripping of pedestrians or bicycles. If cases such as these occur, the owner of the object may be liable for damages which occurred. Trash disposed of on the roadside should be placed inside your space closest to the road. The road belongs to the citizens, and should be a safe and comfortable place for everyone. < Composting Food Waste Using a Cardboard Box: A Class for Parent and Child >

Join this class as a parent and child pair of *Hamura* City to learn about recycling food waste using a card board box. Composting food wastes in this *mikan* box sized container reduces the mass of the kitchen wastes, and creates fertilizer, resulting in reduction of the total burnable waste.

This is perfect for your child's summer project. *You will be asked to fill out a questionnaire.

Fertilizers can be made by placing the mixture of enriched soil containing microscopic organisms and kitchen wastes in the cardboard box. Composting refers to the process of decomposition to the substance inside.

< 2016 Dioxins Level Analysis for Flue Gas >

Report from Nishitama Sanitary Association Environment Management Center

Dioxins analysis on the flue gas output from *Nishitama* Sanitary Association Environment Management Center (our local waste management facility) and on the air of the facility's neighborhoods were conducted (7 times at the waste facility and 4 times at schools) during FY2016. All those analysis results showed that dioxins levels in the tested flue gas and the air achieved the safety standards regulated under The Environmental Air-Quality Standard and The National Pollution Control Agreement.

The air samples were taken at the following locations:

Hamura Dai-San Junior High School (at rooftop), Hamura Shourin Elementary School (at rooftop), Hamura Asahi Kouen (at standing height), Mizuho Dai-Yon Elementary School (at rooftop), Mizuho Fujimi Kouen (at standing height).

< Paper Trash & Cloth Waste Collection on Rainy Day >

June is rainy season in Japan. Please follow the rules for recyclable trash A.

- ◆ Paper Trash (newspaper, commercial bill, magazine, cardboard, book, miscellaneous paper, etc.)
 Wet paper trash can be recycled. It is best to use a pulp twine for bundling the papers in consideration for the recycle process efficiency. Please put it out for collection at the usual spot even on a rainy day, so the collection workers can easily find it. No need for placing it under the eaves.
- ♦ Cloth Waste which become Uncollectable if Wet (used clothing, old linen, etc.)
 Wet cloth kind materials can not be recycled. Even if bagged, the clothes might get wet during the collection work. If it rains on the designated collection day for cloth kind waste, do not try to dispose of it, just put it out on the next designated collection day.
 - ① Recyclable string should be used for recyclable A trash at collection.
 - ② Used underwears, socks and heavily soiled cloth can not be recycled → Burnable Trash.

NOTIFICATION OF MEDICATION COST DIFFERENCE OF INNOVATOR/GENERIC DRUGS Late to Subscribers of Elderly Medical Insurance Program

A notification in the title (ジェネリック医薬品利用差額通知書) will be mailed out to applicable residents who are a National Health Insurance's Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Program member and were prescribed brand-name drugs.

This notification which is mailed in June and December, lists the names and patient's cost of purchased medicines, and also provides the cost difference between the generic products and brand-name products for those medicines. The stated cost difference is the amount the patient could have saved if he/she changes their prescription drugs to generic drugs by requesting so at a medial institution.

This notification is issued to those taking long-term medication for chronic diseases, to show how an individual can easily help reduce the medical cost for their own benefit.

There are no procedures required to be taken regarding this notification.

~ Why not switch your medication to Generic Drug? ~ Generic drugs are considered identical to the brand-name counterpart in efficacy, safety, dose, strength, route of administration and intended use, and are available at more affordable price. Switching the medication from brand name drug to generic drug, especially in long term use, may greatly reduce the medical cost for patients
