< Late Elderly Medical Insurance Program Co-Payment Rate and Medical Fee Reduction Measures >

Shimin Ka, Kourei Iryou • Nenkin Kakari 🖀 Ext. 138

The co-payment rate for members of the Late Elderly Medical Insurance Program paid at the medical institution is either 10 or 30 percent of the total costs. It is determined by your previous year's income, revised every year on August 1st. Applicable to those older than 75 years old or at the age of 65 to younger than 75 with disability recognized by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government.

10 %»persons whose household had taxable total income after the deductions less than ¥1,450,000.

30 %» household with member who has more than ¥1,450,000 of taxable total income.

It is possible to reduce your co-payment rate to 10%. Those who are eligible will receive a packet including the form 基準収入適用申請書、or Income Evaluation Request for Application for Medical Fee Reduction to be submitted with tax return. Certain standards apply, and certification is required.

Other measures for reducing the self-pay burden:

• The Ceiling Amount Certificate which can be offered to the household which have tax exempt income. To be eligible, you must make application procedures and be certified. Tax exempt households that qualify under standards will be issued a Certificate for NHI Applied-Ceiling Amount/Partial Exemption of Standard Medical Cost (限度額適用/標準負担額減額認定証). Outpatient/medical expenses and Meals will be reduced. Ceiling Amount Reduction Certificate (減額認定証) is valid until July 31st (Mon). It will be renewed for households the tax exempt households which has acquired certification, and a new certificate valid from August 1st will be sent to these households in late July. Procedures to renew are not necessary.

• For those who are or older having disability specified under late elderly medical insurance:

特定疾病療養受療証, or Certification for Specific Illness Treatment will be sent to patients whose illnesses take time to heal. By presenting the 特定疾病療養受療証, or Certification for Specific Illness Treatment, there will be a ¥10,000 ceiling amount applied at each medical institution used. Certain standards apply. Please inquire. You will need your identification, my number, inkan (seal) when you apply for the certificate.

< Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Notification >

The Union of Municipalies which incorporate the Late-Elderly Insurance Plan determines the premium amound levied to members, and they will issue a Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Notification (後期高齢者医療保険料決定通知書) which will be mailed to the insured members in mid-July enclosed with a premium amount notification based on 2016 income. Your packet will differ according to payment method.

Premium Reduction is possible depending on the amount of income. Please inquire if your conditions apply. If you will start your bank transfer from April to have premiums deducted from pension, there will be adjustment for any difference accumulated in the previous three deposits made. If you turned 75 years old after April 2nd, or have transferred from another municipality, you will receive notification and the payment slips. For those whose final return of 2016 is not yet filed, the premium amount notification will only state the fixed levy. Once his/her 2016 taxable income is filed, the income-based levy will be calculated and he/she will be notified. You must have completed the tax returns for the previous year to receive this reduction.

~Tired of dealing with periodical cash payment?~

If your premium payments are not yet automatically deducted from pension, we recommend switching your premium payment method to bank transfer, and avoid having to worry about the due date for each installment, as well as having to pay by cash. To change your payment method to bank transfer, please fill in an enclosed request form (口座振替依賴書) and submit it to your financial institution. To switch the method from deduction from pension to bank transfer, an additional procedure is required at the city hall.

< Long-Term Care Insurance (Kaigo Hoken) Notification >

There will be a FY 2016 Premium Notification and Statement (介護保険料額決定通知書·納入通知書) which will be mailed in early July to those who are enrolled in this the long term care insurance program at age 65 or older (Class 1 policy holder). *Long-term Care Insurance premium is reevaluated every 3 years based on the accumulation of demand for services which took place in the city. Premium contribution is the main source of revenue to fund this insurance program

Age 65 or older (Class 1 policy holder)

<u>How the Premium is Calculated</u>: Your previous year's aggregate income is categorized into one of the 13 levels of premium coverage. (Total income is categorized accordingly. Please ask for details.)

The two payment methods for Class-1 policyholders as explained below.

• Special Collection Method (特別徴収): Premiums are automatically deducted from pension. The annual pension amount is ¥180,000 or more.

• Ordinary Collection Method (普通徴収): Please pay by using a cash payment slip or by bank transfer The annual pension amount is less than ¥180,000, and taxable pension does not exist.

Even if you are eligible for the special collection, you may be considered for ordinary collection if:

○You turned 65 years old during the fiscal year.
 ○You transferred from another municipality
 ○Your pension payment was stopped

○You are paying off a credit of pension as collateral, and you do not earn any pension amount.

Age 40 to 64 (Class 2 policy holder)

<u>How the Premium is Calculated</u>: Your premiums are calculated based on national health insurance type that you have, and both national health insurance premiums and Long-term Care Insurance premiums are paid. In the event when a need arises for nursing care, please consult with the *Chiiki Houkatsu Shien* Center. Consultation is required before you use the long term care services. City hall, Ext. 196

\clubsuit If you are having difficulty with paying the premiums... \clubsuit_{\circ}

If overdue premiums accumulate without a reason of exceptional circumstances, and it may affect the benefit eligibility. Please do not let over-due taxes accumulate, just consult with *Nouzei-tantou* in city hall about special measures provided for those in difficult financial situation. There is also premium reduction and grace system for those whose property was severely damaged by fire or floods/disaster.

< Certification for Long Term Care Ceiling Amount Certification Card >

Depending on the income level, you will be able to qualify for a ceiling amount with your long-term care dwelling and meal payments, which normally are not funded by the care system. The costs which exceed this ceiling will be funded by the insurance system. Term of validity is one year from August 1st to July of the following year. The city has sent reminder in June to those who need to make renewal procedures for this Long Term Care Ceiling Amount Certification Card.

①<u>The income requirements</u>: Oincome for all members of household are tax exempt

○ Your spouse living at another household has income which is tax exempt. ②<u>Assets</u>_○You or your spouse (whether or not living together) has an account balance below ¥20 million, and if you do not have a spouse less than ¥10 million. Please consult with City Hall to seek assistance for Long Term Care Payment Ceiling Amount certification. < Reduction of Costs for Care Services Used Under the Long Term-Care Insurance >

The policy which reduces cost when you use your elderly nursing care services is for eligible tax exempt households. Consult prior to the actual use of the services. You must apply to the following:

- Annual income is less than ¥1.5 million if single, and income is less than sum of each added member of household x ¥500,000.
- Account balance is ¥3.5 million for single person, and balance is less than sum of each added member of household x ¥1million.
- Does not own any other assets Is not receiving any financial assistance from relatives.
- Has no arrears in tax payments.

Services for which costs are reduced by this policy are nursing care service at residence (or prevention services) and care at nursing home or facility, for which you gain prior approval from the City Hall. <u>Inquiries:</u> Kourei Fukushi Kaigo ka Kaigo Hoken Kakari **2** Ext. 143

< Co-Payment Rate Determination Certificate for Long Term Care Insurance Subscribers >

A "Co-Payment Rate Determination Certificate" will be mailed out in the middle of July to people who have been certified as a person in need for support or needing long term care indicating the payment rate that they will have (10 -20%). The term of validity for the certification is for one year. Present this certificate to the nursing facility after August 1st if using nursing care services.

The co-payment rate for some Long Term Care Insurance subscribers who are 65 years old or older, holding income above standard (Please ask for details.) will pay 20% co-payment burden when nursing care services under the Long Term Care Insurance are used.

< Renewal of National Health Insurance Elderly Member Card >

The current National Health Insurance Elderly Member Card (国民健康保険高齡受給者証, issued to NHI members of age 70~74) will expire on July 31st(Mon). The new card will be mailed to the current card holders before the end of July. The validity of the new card is from August 1st(Tue) to July 31st (Tue), 2018.

The co-payment rate for treatment costs at medical facilities for those turning 70-74 years old in FY 2017 (with the exclusion of those who have been recognized as having disability specified under late elderly medical insurance) has changed.

Subscriber of NHI 70-74, ►Income Earners <u>exceeding annual income of ¥1,450,000</u> pay 30%. ►persons with income less than annual income of ¥1,450,000.

If you use a [4 Facilities Discount Ticket], a reimbursement can be received which will be paid by bank transfer to the designated bank account.



Exemption from pension premium payments is applied to low income earners. If you are unemployed, certain conditions for exemption may be applied. The exemption application request for premiums payments due July 2017 through June 2018 will start on July 1st (Sat). Request for exemption from payments going back to 2 years and 1 month can also be submitted. Please inquire for details. You will need to submit your *Nenkin Techou* (Booklet).Please inform us if you have not filed for tax return due to having no income. The tax return is needed in order to make sufficient evaluation for exemption. A tax certificate from your previous municipality of residence is needed for people who recently moved to *Hamura* City, and if unemployed you will need your *Rishokuhyou* (separation notice from the previous employer).

<u>The age for eligibility of exemption will be revised</u>: Until June of 2016, the eligibility for exemption was for those younger than age 30. < Heatstroke – Please Be Aware of the Risk ! > 熱中症に注意しよう

Heat exhaustion can occur to people in a place with high temperature, high humidity and no breeze. Little children and older people have an especially higher risk of being affected. The prevention is important. Indoor conditions also need to be taken into account. More people are actually carried by ambulance for heat exhaustion symptoms happening in indoor places than at outdoor places. Cooperation is asked from everyone in order to protect the vulnerable people.*Pay attention to sudden rise in temperature. *Please use air conditioners or fans as needed even during the period when power conservation is advised.

How to prevent Heat Exhaustion:

- Use AC and fan at indoors
- Wear hats and use umbrellas to avoid direct sunlight
- Even if you're not feeling thirsty, make sure to take drinks often
- If you sweat a lot, salt is also needed
- Use a thermometer indoor and check the temperature
 When the temperature is very high, use the air conditioner and fan
- Prevent direct sunlight coming into the room

• Get a balanced diet and sleep well Watch out for these symptoms:

Light symptoms... Dizziness, muscle ache, sweating for a long time

Moderate symptoms... Headache, sickness, and tiredness

Severe symptoms... Unconsciousness, seizure, high fever, non-responsiveness
