< My Number News №. 15 >

The "My Number Portal Website" is the online public service website at which you can view the access log of your 12 digit individual number assigned to you, which includes your personal information and if there was use of your number for administrative procedures, it will be listed.

To use the "My Number Portal Website", access the website, and log-in. The online verification of identity is made through electronic-based individual authentication certificate, which is inside the IC chip imbedded in the "My number" individual number card issued to you. (* An IC reader and computer are needed.)

If you requested not to include an electronic-based individual authentication certificate at initial registration by checking the block omitting e-certificate for the individual number card, please update your registration by adding the e-certificate function to the card.

Also, if you forgot your password for the e-certificate that you set up when the card was issued, please reassign a new number.

Procedures can be made at the Shimin Ka section on the 1st floor of city hall by coming with your card. If you do not have access to the internet at your home, please come to the 3rd floor *Souma Ka* section's Information Disclosure, Confidentiality Protected Service. It is available from Sep.1st (Fri) from 8:30AM ~ 5PM on weekdays excluding holidays.

障害のある方のタクシー費用・自動車ガソリン助成

< Filing for Subsidization of Taxi Fare or Gasoline Costs by Residents with Disability (First Half) > (Takushī Hiyou / Jidousha Gasorinhiyou Josei)

Applications for subsidization of payment for purchase of taxi fare or gasoline costs during the first half of the fiscal year of 2017 will be accepted. To be eligible, you must be have one of the following disability certificates:

- Physical Disability Certificate grade 1 to 2 (3 for lower limb, trunk, or internal dysfunction)
- Certificate for Mental Deficiency grade 1 to 2 "Ai No Techou"
- Persons with brain paralysis or progressive muscular atrophy who has already been certified

To receive subsidy, you must be certified in advance.

<u>Limitation for Subsidization</u>: ¥ 15,000 (for the months of April through September)

If the date on which you were certified is past the start of the term for certification, the limit will vary from the above.

<u>Period for Application</u>: Oct. 1st (Sun) ~ 10th (Tue), 8:30AM ~ 5PM Shougai Fukushi Ka at the 1st Floor (Counter closes for lunch at NOON ~1PM.) Services for this will not be available on Oct 9th (Mon, Holiday). If you are not able to file during the period for application, it can be filed with the subsidization for latter half of the fiscal year.

< Tokyo Olympic / Paralympic Games Update >

Badminton will be played as an official Olympic sport for the first time in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. There are the singles and doubles style of the game, and players compete for 2 sets, in which the winner is the first to achieve 21 points at each game. The player who wins both sets becomes the overall winner. The court size differs according to 6 competing classes. The Paralympic special rule is that player's lower part of their body should be in contact their wheelchair seat when the shuttle is being shot.

The player positions themselves to make a counter attack with swift moves in response to the direction of the shuttle, and uses precise and coordinated movement of the chair as a calculation is made of when the predicted fall point will be. <u>Inquiries</u>: Tokyo Olympic / Paralympic Games Preparations Office, **B**Ext. 344

飼い主のいない猫について

< Street Cats That Do Not Have a Home >

The number of cats that do not have a home have been increasing gradually within the past years in *Hamura* City. The reason for this increase is that the owner responsible for the care of the cat abandons them to let them go astray at the river side or in parks. (Abandoning a cat is a felony.) Cats that do not have a home tend to live in an insufficient environment, and live shorter and unhealthy lives compared to those cats that have a specific owner. The city has dealt with this problem with the help of volunteer associations by addressing the animal rights and the environmental concerns.

Nuisances by cats to the urban environment are reduced by efforts such as citizens' contributing information regarding street cats, or cooperating with the activities of volunteer associations.

< Subsidy for Fertility Treatment >

Hamura City provides subsidy to female residents who plan to receive high-cost Fertility Treatments, such as external fertilization and micro-fertilization. This subsidy is to partially support the treatment cost. <u>Eligibility</u>: The following conditions apply:

- Prior to the application for the subsidy in Hamura City, you must be registered under the Tokyo Metropolitan Government's Fertility Treatment Subsidy Program. This subsidization is for each treatment's costs which exceed the subsidy which is available from Tokyo.
- You are a resident of *Hamura* City who has continuously lived at a resident in *Hamura* since the start of your fertility treatment. You are not receiving similar aid from other municipalities.

The amount of subsidy:

Maximum for high-cost Fertility Treatment is up to ¥50,000, per treatment. Other conditions apply such as the year in which you applied or age that you were when applying for subsidy. Please call the *Hoken* Center for details. Inquiries: *Hoken* Center, 555-1111 **≊**Ext. 623
