< Action to Be Taken When Ballistic Missile May Hit >

When a threat toward Japan becomes apparent, the Japanese Government will immediately issue a warning through the J-Alert.

Inquiry: Kikikanri-Ka Kikikanri-kakari, &Ext. 217

J-Alert (全国瞬時警報システム Zenkoku Shunji Keihou Shisutemu) is a nationwide alert system designed to deliver alert for most critical emergency by broadcasting it through local community wireless system without taking authorizing procedures at local government level in the event that requires citizens to beware of sudden emergency or to quickly evacuate or shelter themselves.

The alert information is distributed via satellite-based transmission system. When a local terminal receives the alert, it automatically activates the community wireless system, enabling the central government to directly and quickly inform its' citizens of imminent threats. The alert information that may be transmitted by this system may be for; earthquake (early warning, hypocenter, magnitude), tsunami (precaution, presence), volcano eruption, significant meteorological disaster and military threats.

The following announcement will be voiced in the alert *announced ONLY in Japanese

An emergency signal will be blasting from the J-Alert system along with the following J-Alert message:

「Tadachini Hinan.」 (Evacuate Immediately This will be repeated.)

「Tadachini Tatemonono Naka E, Matawa Chika ni Hinan Shietekudasai」

(Protect yourself by going into a building or underground nearby.)

「Misairu Ga Rakka Suru Kanousei Ga Arimasu」 (A missle may reach Japan.)

「Tadachini Hinan Shite Kudasai.」 (Please evacuate immediately. Go inside immediately)

Please stay calm

If you are outside: Enter a sturdy building or an underground area.

If no buildings are nearby: Either take cover behind what you can, or lie on the ground protecting the head. If you are indoors: Stay away from windows or relocate to a room without windows.

AS the MISSLE STRIKES NEARBY

When outdoors, cover your mouth with a handkerchief, go inside to a sealed building or evacuate at a location on the windward side. (the side or direction from which the wind is coming from)

When indoors, shut off ventilation, close windows, and seal any cracks including window frames.

- 1. When the missile has passed territory or the air space of Japan, announcement will be made at prefectures that will be affected by the threat with additional warning "Please report any suspicious items that you find to the police or fire station Do not attempt to remove it."
- 2. If it is inevitable that the missile will hit the territory, or fall into territorial waters, details as to where it struck and danger will be announced. Please keep yourself informed through various forms of media. Stay attentive to announcement on TV, Radio, local community wireless system, e-mail and stay calm.
- 3. If there has been damage done by the missile within city limits, various local organizations (Police, Fire, and Self Defense Force) will respond to disaster management according to the provisions of the Basic Act on Disaster Control Measures
- 4. The Tokyo Metropolitan Government has designated the local elementary schools and junior high schools, jidokans, Ikoi no Sato, Fukushi Center, Fujimi Park, Musashino Park, Asahi Park as evacuation sites. (28) Hamura City will notify its' citizens regarding the instruction for evacuation, (Since the announcement is in Japanese, please try to ask a member of your local community for help or get someone to translate if there is a member who speaks English to enable your safe evacuation during
 - get someone to translate if there is a member who speaks English to enable your safe evacuation during an emergency situation such as this.) however please follow the instructions of J-Alert warnings as the ballistic missile is expected to hit within 10 minutes.

Hamura City will partially subsidize the cost of influenza vaccination for residents of age 65 or older.

<u>Vaccination Period</u>: October 16th(Mon) ~ January 31st(Wed) 2018

① at age 65 or older, ② at age 60 to 64 years and has any heart, kidney or respiratory disease, or immune dysfunction caused by AIDS. (patients② must obtain a physician's certificate or present Physical Disability Certificate grade1) Fee: ¥2500

< How to Dispose of Grass, Leaves, and Tree Branches >

Grass, leaves and tree branches collected from private property can be disposed as a regular Burnable Waste Collection without any charge if disposed properly in compliance with the following rules.

*Tree branches - please bundle the branches tightly. An individual branch must be less than 10cm in diameter, a bundle must be less than 50cm in length and a diameter of 30cm or less.

*Grass/Leaves - please put into transparent or translucent bags with a capacity of 45 liters or less.

(Sand and stones should be excluded as much as possible.)

*Up to 6 bundles or bags (combined) will be accepted in one collection day.

- * If tree branches larger than the above standard bundle of 50cm, individual branch larger than 10cm in diameter, dispose of them as oversized trash by making appointment for collection (\$\frac{1}{2}\$570-7733), or direct carry- in to the Recycling Center. (There will be a fee.)
- *Wood components from furniture or interior goods, broken-down lumber, and other wood products cannot be collected by the city for free of charge. If such pieces are less than 50cm long or 10cm in diameter, you can dispose of them in city-designated burnable waste bags (to be purchased), otherwise, dispose of them as oversized trash

TOKYO METROPOLITAN AREA MINIMUM WAGE has been revised

As of October 1st 2017, the minimum hourly wage in Tokyo was revised to ¥958.

(The minimum wage system is a system that employer must pay the employee a wage that is not less than the minimum wage formulated by the government on the basis of the Minimum Wages Law.

In principal, the system applies to all workers and their employers, regardless of pay structure or any forms and the titles of employment, full or part-time, temporary work or side job, etc. Wages targeted as subject to the minimum wage are only the wages corresponded with usual working time and working days.)

There are different minimum wages in different areas of the country, and specific minimum wages for certain industries.
