The Japan National Government designates the week of December 4th as Human Rights Awareness Week in Japan, which aims to promote the awareness, understanding and respect for human rights of all people. Let's work together to create a society where every life is cherished and respected.

A lot of elderly people are suffering from employment discrimination or physical/mental abuse by their care takers. Let's make our society free from human rights violations. The elderly have rights to be happy.

Respect for Foreign Residents Residing in Japan

Ordinance Regarding the Elimination of Unfair Treatment Towards People of Origins Other Than the Mainland Japan was enacted in June 2016. As the Olympic Year nears, we will see many foreigners. There is much diversity in the world, and learning about the many cultures can expand your horizon.

♦ Support Equal Rights and Social Participation of Disabled People

Society should respect the rights of a disabled person just as much as we would respect any other person's rights. We must realize a society in which no one is treated differently on the basis of whether or not they have disability.

❖ Eliminating Present Day Buraku Minority Discrimination

Some that were wrongfully considered as outcast from Japanese social order have been discriminated and ostracized. The Act on the Promotion of the Elimination of Buraku Discrimination went into effect in Dec.

♦ Equality for Persons with Gender Identity Disorders or Sexual Orientation

People with a different gender identity should not have to face discrimination. They should be offered chances to achieve potential socioeconomic status, and should not be marginalized by society.

< Water Pipe Maintenance Tips for Winter Season >

► Pipe & Water Meter Protection Measures in Winter ◀

During the mid-winter time, water pipes and water meters may get damaged from severe coldness. In order to prevent such damages, it is strongly recommended to take measures; for instance, wrap the water pipes where you can to give it insulation, and put some insulation material like styrene foam pieces in a meter box.

▶ Water Leakage ◀

In a residential unit, residents are liable for the maintenance of service pipes and water usage meter. It is highly recommended to check for water leakage periodically. If the meter keeps running when you are not using water, or the surrounding area of the water meter is always wet, please contact the *Suidou Jimusho* (Waterworks Department) or a certified plumber for professional inspection and repair work.
