< Understanding Dementia >

Dementia is a state of memory loss and limited ability to make decisions induced by the deterioration of the brain, which gradually leads to the dementia patient's incapacitation.



Most of the reported cases are classified as the Alzheimer type, where the shrinking of the brain is caused by destruction of brain cells. Other symptoms of dementia are caused by strokes or brain hemorrhage. The early diagnosis by a physician can be effective in alleviating symptoms or slowing the progression of the condition. If the elder family member displays symptoms such as:

•forgetting that they already had eaten lunch, and demanding to have lunch again

•not being able to realize that they are having memory loss

they do not understand what calendar date and season it is ▶You should seek help from a certified physician.

 ~ Courses in Nursing Care for Supporting Dementia Patients ~

The correct knowledge of dementia and the tendencies that dementia patients have can be learned at this course. You will not be required to commit to duties after completion of this course.

~ Support from Others is Very Meaningful to Families of Dementia Patients ~

Caring for loved ones with dementia poses many challenges for families and caregivers. Support from the community is very reassurance to these families. Even if they are able to gain assistance from the nursing care program, further help is always required. Dementia can happen to anyone. They need all the help they can get to carry on with their life in their neighborhood by in-home care; often being efforts made by those who are close.

< What to Expect ~ Stages of Change for Embracing the Reality of Dementia >

- The Caregiver's Typical Reaction When Their Family Is Diagnosed
- 1. <u>Bewilderment and Denial</u> It is hard to grasp what is happening at first.
- 2. <u>Confusion, Anger, and Refusal</u> Trying to cope with the reality, having to explore some solution
- 3. <u>Acknowledgment</u> Reassurance after obtaining informative resources or being able to receive consultation
- 4. <u>Embracing Reality</u> Understanding becomes deeper, and the family member can relate to the patient.

< Changes to the National Health Insurance Which Will Become Effective from April >

Administrative responsibilities of the National Health Insurance will be handed over to the metropolitan and prefectural governments effective April 1st. Until now, each local municipality had managed their own National Health Insurance program, however after this revision goes into effect, they will no longer do so. Local city halls will continue to provide administrative services for citizens related to the National Health Insurance program as before even after the revision.

The prefectural government name will be placed on newly issued Health Insurance Cards from April 2018. Also, in cases where households applicable to the high cost medical care benefit program move their address within the prefecture (metropolitan area), records of the household will be handed on as appropriately to make a consecutive count of the number of times benefits were received, and the number of times will not be reset by obtaining a new address. (There is an annual limit to the number of times a benefit can be used.) The national health insurance premium rate will be determined by the figures provided by the prefectural governments. Notices regarding this will be sent out by the municipalities.

Hamura City designates February, May and September as "Accurate Waste Separation Promotional Month." The city has conducted the content analysis of local burnable waste from city, in which was found out that, there were 14.6% of recyclable resources mixed in the burnable waste in 2017, compared to 8.14% of 200kg of randomly collected burnable waste seen in 2016. More awareness in regards to conserving our valuable resources is needed. Paper and plastic products mixed into burnable waste increased, and 5% of the 200kg was also otherwise edible foods wasted and disposed of as kitchen waste.

Decreasing burnable garbage will be very important and an effective tactic. Less burnable waste being processed results in less city budget spent, and the more recyclable resources collected the more recycle profit gained for the city. The pension system offers benefits for disability holders by the Disability Basic Pension Plan. Certain requirements must be met, such as having no arrears in pension premiums. If you were diagnosed as having a physical disability level 1 or 2 at the first examination by a physician before reaching the age of 20, you may be eligible for the Disability Basic Pension benefit. The elder who is 60-65 years of age that has never received pension benefits in the past may also be eligible. Please inquire and seek consultation.

Pension amount is determined for the head of household, and the dependents that rely on their income.
