明治150年 羽村のあゆみ

< Hamura City's 150 Year History Explored >

150 years ago, Hamura City was part of a "Han", or territory led by a lord called *hanshu*. In 1871, this system was abolished as the "*Ken*", or prefecture system was introduced. Hamura was integrated into the Kanagawa Prefecture. Later, the Hamura area became part of *Tama* Village along with neighboring villages. *Tama* Village was then later divided into four regional east, west, south, and north sections called "*gun*". The area of Hamura was included as part of the west section ~ *Nishitama* Gun. However, shortly after, the area of Hamura became Hamura Village by becoming independent from the *Tama* Village.

In 1889, another merge of territory between neighboring villages created *Nishitama* Village. In 1893, a wide area of the present day Tama Region became part of Tokyo.

As the advancement of technology took place, in 1894, Ome Tetsudo Railways started operation giving birth to the Hamura and Ozaku Station that we know in the present day. (Trains used to run on coal.) The first electric power grid was set up in 1912 by the Teikoku Dento Co. (Imperial Electric Co.) It wasn't until 1956 that Hamura Town was established. Then the population was 1,000,004.

In 1991, Hamura City was born, and the population has been seen gradually rising with time, becoming popular as a town with beautiful natural landscape remaining intact, and the safe drinking water supply. Hamura City's Municipal History Compilation Office is in the process of making a literary creation based on the research. Their topic of research is on a wide scale ranging from the archaeological artifacts to the modern times. <u>Inquiries</u>: Municipal History Compilation Office, Ext. 365

MEDICAL INSURANCE FEE for MEMBERS of the Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Program/System

There will be a special collection of Late Elderly Medical Insurance Fees (deducted from your Public Pension) which will be withdrawn from your bank account in April, June, and August. This is necessary because the previous year's income, which will be the basis for calculating what amount will be charged for the individual, has not been confirmed. The tentative medical insurance fee will be withdrawn, and the difference between amount charged in the special collection and the confirmed collection amount for October, December, and February of the following year's withdrawal will settle the difference. 高齢者肺炎球菌予防接種

< Pneumococcal Vaccination for Elderly >

The pneumococcal vaccine was included in the vaccination schedule implemented by the City from October 1st, 2014. Vaccinations for elderly residents at age 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, and 100 or older will be offered. Eligibility: *Hamura* residents who have not received this vaccination who meet one of the following:

- ① will reach age 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, and 100 or older at year in which the vaccination is administered
- ② age 60 to younger than 65 as of the vaccination date and have any heart, kidney or respiratory disease, or immune dysfunction caused by AIDS. (patient ② must obtain a physician's certificate or present Physical Disability Certificate grade 1)

Fee for Residents: ¥4,000 will be subsidized, so please pay the balance at a medical facility.

<u>Location</u>: Medical facilities in *Hamura* City <u>Term</u>: ~ March 30th (Sat), 2019

If vaccination is not received within the specified dates, subsidization will not be applied.

<u>How to be Inoculated</u>: Reserve at designated medical facility located in *Hamura* City, and bring the *Sesshu Josei Ken (coupon), Health Insurance Card (Kenkou Hokenshou) on the date of appointment.

Those who are eligible have been sent a letter including the coupon from the city in early April.

The subsidy for Pneumococcal Vaccination for Elderly will be offered until fiscal year 2018.
