< The Oga Lotus Viewing Event >

The *Oga* Lotus in the *Negarami-mae Suiden* (paddy fields) can be seen blooming from late July to Early August. They bloom only in early morning, and are said to be cultivated from 2000-year-old seeds back to the revival. At this viewing event, you can experience drinking juice or Sake from a lotus leaf using a stem as a straw (a manner called "*Kayouhai*"), a gesture wishing for good health and longevity. Also enjoy the outdoor tea ceremony and fresh local vegetable markets.

< Hamura City Ordinance Prohibiting the Littering and Smoking in Public Space >

Hamura City has an ordinance pertaining to the prohibition of littering garbage and leaving dog feces, and designation of the Public Non-smoking Area. The amount of litter collected has decreased, however the continued observance of this ordinance by each person is requested.

We hope that the law will not be necessary in the future, and we also hope that our city will become a place where one can be healthy and live in safety.


Violations are: ①[Prohibition of Littering Garbage and Leaving Dog Feces] (city wide)

② [Designation of the Public Non-Smoking Area]

¥5,000 yen will be charged as a fine for violation of these articles, and not complying when warned.

< Committee for the Inquest of Prosecution >

The "Kensatsu Shinsa Kai" – Committee for the Inquest of Prosecution is the committee whose members are randomly chosen Japanese citizens with the right to vote and their purpose is to examine and review a prosecutor's decisions not to indict cases, and evaluate the prosecutor discretion in the judicial ruling.

When a Committee for the Inquest of Prosecution receives a complaint against a decision not to indict from an individual or a civic organization, they submit a legally binding recommendation to the Prosecutor's Office.

Anyone who has a legal address in Japan is able to make a request to the committee for assessment of a case and to bring it into court for further examination. IMMUNIZATION~Have You Been Vaccinated Already?

Immunity which was handed down from mother to child is only effective for a certain period after birth. Immunity against diseases will decline naturally as child grows. If you have lost your questionnaire sheet or have recently moved in to Hamura, please bring your maternal and child handbook to the center to receive assistance.

Notes to be Remembered

You must withhold from immunization for term required between vaccinations.

There are vaccinations which require several injections after certain intervals.

The age varies depending on the vaccination which will be made. If vaccination is not completed within this age, one must receive it on their own terms and will not be funded. Please visit Hoken Center for assistance.

Hepatitis B B型肝炎

Eligibility: 3 doses are administered from 2 months old ~ the day before their 1st birthday

Hib Vaccine and Pediatric Pneumococcal Vaccine ヒブワクチン・小児用肺炎球菌

Eligibility: 3 doses are administered from 2 months old ~ 4 years old (the day before their 5th birthday)

Number of vaccine: It varies depending on the child's age.

BCG

Eligibility: 1 dose is administered until the day before their 1st birthday

DTPP Combination Vaccine (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio)四種混合

Eligibility: 4 doses are administered from 3 months old ~ 7 years and 5 months old

※Please inquire regarding the balancing between other DTP and other combination vaccinations (Polio).

Chicken Pox 水痘 (みずぼうそう)

Eligibility: The day before reaching 1 year old to the day before reaching 3 years old who have never been contracted.

Number of vaccines: 2 doses (must withhold 3 months after 1st shot)

Measles and Rubella 麻しん・風しん

1st term: 1 dose is administered from the day before reaching 1 year old ~ day before reaching 2 years old

2nd term: 1 dose for those who are 5-6 years of age

*2nd term must be administered within the year prior to the entry to elementary school.

Japanese Encephalitis Vaccine 日本脳炎

1st term -3 doses are administered within the age of 3 years old ~ 7 years and 5 months old

*There must be 6 days in between doses.

2nd term - 1 dose within the age of 9 years old ~ the day before reaching 13 years old

Please come to the Hoken Center to be inoculated

*You can apply for free immunization if you are not up to date with vaccinations due to the recent denial for some apparent severe side effects questioning the validity of vaccination; if born between July 15th, 1998 and April 1, 2007 before your 20th birthday, or if born between April 2nd, 2007 and October 1st, 2009 for 1st and 2nd terms of Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination (9 ~ 13 yr old).

Applicable households will be notified by mail by late July.

< Self-Pay Burden for National Health Insurance High Medical Expense Benefit (70 or older) will Change >

The medical expense which exceeds the ceiling amount can be claimed (by monthly units) as a High Expense Medical Benefit. Prior certification is required. The amount that will be reimbursed is designated according to the income level. This self-pay burden ceiling amount will be revised as of August 1st, 2018, if you are older than 70 years old. Low income earners will not be affected by this change. Please inquire for details.

< Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Program ~ Renewal of Ceiling Amount Certificate/ Certificate for Partial Exemption of Standard Medical Cost >

July 31st (Tue) is the expiration date for your Ceiling Amount Certificate/ Certificate for Partial Exemption of Standard Medical Cost under the Late-Elderly Medical Insurance Program.

If you already qualify, and your household was tax exempt for FY 2017, you will receive a renewed Certification Card which will be mailed in late July. There is no need for registration procedures.

Certificate for Exemption of Costs: This card is need when you approach the counter at medical facilities and is a certificate which sets the maximum limit of medical charges for each facility when making a visit to clinics or when becoming hospitalized.

Eligibility: Residents whose household members are exempt from municipal resident tax

If you qualify but have not yet been certified, please apply for these certificates. You will need to present personal identification such as the my number individual number card and your seal (*inkan*).

< Self-Pay Burden- Medical Support System for Physical or Mental Disability Certificate Holders >

As of August 1st (Wed), the Physical or Mental Disability Certificate Holders' Self-Pay Burden under the Medical Support System will be revised for households categorized as inhabitant with taxable income. The amount of ¥14,000 per month or ¥144,000 per year is applied as self-pay burden limit for medical charges at each facility. Tax Exempt Households will not be affected by the revision.

Hamura City partially subsidizes accommodation fees for use of facilities which are designated as destinations by the city for holiday lodging for disability certificate holders.
