< Tokyo's Support for Survivors of Natural Disasters for Home and Business Owners >

There is a policy in effect offering exemption from tax obligation to Tokyo citizens in great need of support for recovering from damage inflicted by a natural disaster. Applicable home /property owners (real estate acquisition tax payers) or private business entities who pay enterprise tax can either become exempt from or have partial exemption applied to their tax payment, and is offered for the tax payment obligation which has not passed the due date. You must consult with the Metropolitan Tax Agency to be certified under this policy and register before the due date indicated on your tax payment slip in order to receive support. Hamura City offers a health check program in which several health examinations are provided free of charge to Hamura residents who turn 30 or 35 years old in FY2018. It aims to help prevent the Life-style Disease.

Examination Date: October 21st (Sun) 9AM ~ 4PM at the Hoken Center

Eligibility: persons who meet all of the following conditions;

- · Registered Hamura residents
- born between April 2nd 1988 ~ April 1st 1989, or between April 2nd 1983 ~ April 1st 1984.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ having no other opportunity for a similar health checkups
- not being pregnant or not recovering from giving birth Fee: Free Capacity: first 50

<u>Examination Items</u>: Measurements of height, weight, waist girth, blood pressure, blood lipid, blood sugar, checking liver function, anemia, taking urinalysis, anemia test, electrocardiogram, etc.

<u>How & Where</u>: The Hoken Center will issue a free checkup ticket, for which you must apply for on the application form first. Once you are issued the free checkup ticket, you can receive the checkup at a participating medical facility in *Hamura* City (list provided with ticket).

Breast Cancer Screening and Cervical Cancer Screening Term 2 第2期乳がん検診 子宮頸がん検診

You can apply for Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening if you have not been examined yet. We advise you to reserve before November, since there is usually an increase in patients at the end of the year. Plan well in advance and receive the screening at your earliest opportunity.

< Breast Cancer Screening >

<u>Date</u>: By appointment between October 1st (Mon) ~ December 28th (Fri) excluding Saturday, Sunday and Holiday <u>Participating Medical Facilities</u>: *Fussa* Hospita, I *Nishimura* Hospital, and Taisei Hospital (located in *Fussa* City) <u>Eligibility</u>: Female residents at age 40 or older as of the examination day who were not tested last fiscal year.

- There is a limit to screening capacity. (first-come first-serve basis.) <u>Fee</u>: ¥1600 *Pay at the hospital *Free for Welfare Recipients. Please bring the Certificate of Welfare Recipient.
- * You will not be eligible if you have had a pacemaker implanted in your chest.

Street Rules for Keeping Safe and Pleasant Streets for Everyone

- Do not set up banners, signboards or product displays on streets without permission.
- Do not illegally-park bicycles / motor bicycles on streets and other public places.
- · Leaving ramp blocks (at the parking entrance/exit) on a street is prohibited.
- Do not dispose of trash or grease into street gutter.
- Do not neglect tree branches or plants growing out to street. It may block the sight or narrow the sidewalk. Road Law States that: (**)
- In case of a traffic accident caused by a personal thing or a signboard placed on street, or a tree branch growing out to the street, the owner of such item may be called to account for the accident.

< Application for Child-Rearing Allowance >

Child-Rearing Allowance (*Jidou Fuyou Teate*) Program is established to provide independence support to single parent households. Application is needed to receive the allowance. After the approval of qualification, a household may receive the allowances until the first March following the child's 18th birthday.

<u>Eligibility</u>: The applicant's (parent) child meets any of the following conditions $(1) \sim (5)$ under your household. *If child has a disability certification of grade $1 \sim 3$, allowance is provided until term before he/she reaches the age of 20.

- (1) Parents are divorced (2) Father or mother is deceased (3) Father or Mother has severe disability
- (4) Death or survival of father or mother cannot be confirmed
- (5) Other (duty to support is neglected over one year by a parent, or a parent is imprisoned over one year, etc.), Monthly Allowance: First child \(\frac{\text{10}}{030} \) \(\text{\text{\text{42}}},500 \) (determined according to the household income) Added Amount for: Second child \(\frac{\text{\text{500}}}{5020} \) \(\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{410}}}},040, Third child and younger \(\frac{\text{3}}{3},010 \) \(\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{\text{90}}}}}} \) per additional child Your application will be rejected if you have any of the disqualifying conditions:

The child is in foster care. The child is living in a child care institution

The parent or the child does not have a residential address in Japan

The household income of the preceding year exceeded the qualification ceiling

Paperwork needed for application:

- ① Family Registry (*Koseki Shouhon*) of *Hamura* City (official document issued) providing the proof of valid relationship with child who is eligible to receive allowance.
- ② Bank Book from Financial Institution
- ③ Official Stamp "INKAN" which is not the casual stamp type.
- 4 If parents have physical or mental disabilities and are certified accordingly, current certificate
- If you were not registered as a resident in *Hamura* City at January 1 of the year for which you are requesting allowance, please submit tax certificate of previous city of residence. To know more about this allowance program, please inquire to *Kosodate Shien-ka Shien-kakari*, **E**Ext.237.

< Notification of Current Status for Special Child-Raising Allowance >

Recipients of Special Child-Raising Allowance (特別児童扶養手当) are required to submit a Notification of Current Status (現況届) along with the required documents during the designated filing period. < Rate Reduction Applied For National Pension Premium Advance Lump-Sum Payment >

When paying the National Pension premiums in advance in lump-sum of 6 months in advance by bank transfer, some reduction is applied to the yearly premium amount. If you wish to register for the automated bank transfer payment, please do so by the deadline.

This registration need not be renewed yearly. It will be automatically continued in every following year.

■ October~March: 6months lump-sum advance payment (paid in October) → Register by end of August Bank transfer will be made on the 31st of October, however, if the financial institution is closed on 31st, it will be made on the next day of operation.

- (2) The parent of the child in question did not request for extension/ exempt status as stated in (1), child will become 15 years of age by the end of March 2019, and is further required to have a reason of inevitable circumstances hindering completion the compulsory education, determined by the Minister of Education as legitimate.
- (3) You will become older than 16 years of age by the end of March 2019. (Those not applicable to (1) & (4))

Co-Payment Rate for Care Services Used Under the Long Term-Care Insurance

The co-payment rate for use of elderly nursing care services will be changed for some households. Due to the recent revision of the standards under the Long Term Care Insurance Policy, as of August 1st, the set standard 10% or 20% co-payment rate which was applied until then will be changed, and some households that have a certain income will be required to pay a 30% co-payment rate. The co-payment rate is applicable when you use nursing care service at residence (or prevention services) and care at nursing home or facility, and etc. for which you gain prior approval from the City Hall.
