9月2日(日)は総合防災訓練

< HAMURA CITY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY DRILL September 2nd (Sun) 9AM ~ >

You should be self-reliant for protecting your life, and helping others survive!

In all *Hamura* City, the drill demonstrations will take place at 10 public evacuation sites, among those *Hamura Higashi* Elementary School is designated as the main evacuation site this year.

It is important to better the capability for disaster response with practical knowledge gained from conscious efforts for disaster preparedness, which will lead to the protection of your own life. These efforts will pay off during an actual situation as it occurs.

Not only the adults, but also young residents, because they are all recognized as community members, should participate in the drill. Junior High School Students have been joining the drill on a regular basis, improving the effectiveness of the drill. The whole family should participate as well, with the thought in mind that disaster strikes in many forms.



• The main evacuation site of this year's drill is *Hamura Higashi* Elementary School

Students of all grade levels from Higashi Elementary School will be participating in this drill.

The *Fussa* Fire Station and other organizations taking part will set up an Exhibition and Simulation Booth which will have a House for Smoke Simulation at which you can experience a fire.

Stockpile emergency relief supplies will be on display. There will also be an overnight evacuation drill simulating life at shelter facility organized by civil voluntary disaster management organization day prior to this exercise.

*In case of cancellation due to bad weather, it will be announced at 7AM through outdoor public address system.

Assumed Scenario:

» Shortly before 9AM, an emergency earthquake warning is issued by J-Alert (nationwide alert system) which is broadcasted through the outdoor P.A. system city wide. Then at 9AM, a severe earthquake (scale 6-strong) occurs. Following the earthquake, the public emergency siren goes off.

» Disaster Occurrence Notice (Emergency Drill) is distributed to the subscribers of *Hamura* Information Email Service after 9AM when occurrence of natural disaster (evacuation order for the drill) is issued. Even if you are not a subscriber, an extensive notification e-mail will be sent to all who are present in *Hamura* City.

What to Do On the Drill Day

Practice $1 \sim 5$ steps explained below:

What To Do When A Strong Earthquake Happens...



- When a strong earthquake happens, the first and most important thing is to protect yourself. If there is a sturdy furniture near you, <u>drop underneath the furniture, be covered and hold-on</u> to the furniture until the shaking comes to a stop. * For the drill, make-up an assumed scenario (with family or with your co-workers), and try acting according to the assumed situation. These are simple but important to do.
- ② After the shaking stops and you make sure it is safe to take the next action, the first important thing is to check all the fire risk sources (if you are at home or office). Tightly close the main gas tap and switch off the electricity circuit before leaving the place.
- ③ Practice the actual evacuation plan. Make an escape route considering of dangers open fire spreading which may occur and discuss among family members. Go to the public shelter site nearest to your home
- ④ Neighborhood associations and volunteer organizations for disaster preparedness will practice extinguishing fires or providing first-aid to injured persons (requiring evacuation assistance during disaster). These repeated activities can make one move in an agile and proficient manner. It will enhance awareness for helping each other as a community
- ⑤ We should avoid migrating during a time of disaster, according to the Tokyo Metropolitan Government's policy for preventing home-going refugees. Those who are away from home must stay put at their location. Even after safe, you may have to walk home if public transportation's inaccessible. Discover your route to go home on foot, and use the disaster line to connect with your family. Please take this chance and discuss with your family/friends about options for communication method.

HAMURA INFORMATION EMAIL SERVICE

Hamura City provides a public information service which distributes local information via emails. With this system emergency related information will be sent to all subscribers. In addition, you can receive local affairs information in various categories upon your request. There is no fee charged for subscription. *Subscription instruction and email contents are available in Japanese only.

*Mobile internet access fee may apply for receiving the emails from this system.

How to subscribe:

(1) First, Set up your email account able to receive emails from mail@city.hamura.tokyo.jp.

Then send a blank email (no title/message) to hamura@entry.mail-dpt.jp

(2) You will receive an email titled "仮登録受付メール". Open the message, and click on the URL in it which links to the Site Policy page (in Japanese only).

You must complete the registration within 30 minutes from the time you open the page.

- (3) After you indicate that you agree with the terms and conditions (click on 同意する), choose your desired information categories, and click on the icon "確認". Then on the next page, click on "登録"

避難行動要支援者制度

ひなんこうどうようしえんしゃせいど

<Hamura City's Evacuation Plan to Support Those Requiring Evacuation Assistance (避難 行動 要支援者 制度) > There is an evacuation assistance plan activated during a disaster for citizens requiring special consideration

such as elderly citizens, physically or mentally challenged citizens, and some foreigners residing in Japan with difficulty to understand Japanese. They will be included in the list of citizens requiring evacuation assistance maintained by Hamura City, which provides a basis for cooperating agencies to be aware of their presence so that they can provide prompt support that these people need.

Please note that this registration system does not guarantee you will receive a special assistance in time of a disaster. It will provide disaster response personnel where the registered help-needing persons are likely to be found by their addresses, but those personnel may not be able to reach them swiftly.

It is most recommended for residents to have a friendly relationship with neighborhood people regularly in order to build a network for collecting local information and helping each other.

List of Citizens Requiring Evacuation Assistance in Hamura City's Evacuation Plan

The list of registered citizens requiring evacuation assistance will be created according to the provisions of the Basic Act on Disaster Control Measures. Hamura City's Disaster Control Plan specifies the area in which this information is used when passed on to the various local organizations that will respond to disaster management. If registrants can offer consent for their information to be released to these agencies, it will be utilized when an organization performs their disaster relief efforts, and neighborhood watch functions will be enhanced to be better prepared for a disaster, following the guidelines that stipulate which information is relevant to the disaster relief efforts.

Registration of citizens to the "List of Citizens Requiring Evacuation Assistance" (避難行動要支援者名簿) will be made under the Hamura City's Disaster Control Plan. This list will be utilized by the neighborhood associations for practicing evacuating procedures in the Comprehensive Emergency Drill, which is schedule to be held on September 2nd (Sun).

Eligibility

Hamura City Residents who are not long term hospital / nursing home dwellers that fulfill following criteria:

- 1. Households comprised of age 75 or older
- 2. Certified as Long-term Care Level 3 or higher
- Holders of 3. Physical Disability Certificate (身体障害者手帳) Level 1 or 2
 - 4. Intellectual Disability Certificate (愛の手帳) Level 1 or 2
 - 5. Health and Welfare Handbook for Mentally Disabled (精神障害者保健福祉手帳) Level 1 or 2
 - 6. Those needing special assistance in time of evacuation with incurable diseases.
 - 7. Those certified by the mayor as needing evacuation assistance during evacuation.

Please obtain a pamphlet and registration form at the *Kiki Kanri Ka, Kiki Kanri Kakari* on the 2nd Floor of the City Hall. (If you are not applicable to above and wish to be included in the list, please call to make a request.)

Personal Information Included Are

The required information for registry is as follows.

Name, Date of Birth, gender, address, point of contact (phone number), and a reason for needing assistance which was provided at time of registry.

The Various Agencies which will Handle the Information

Neighborhood Association, Civil Voluntary Disaster Management Organization, Commissioned Welfare Volunteers, Fire Brigades, Hamura City Social Welfare Organizations and Traffic Safety Organizations, *Fussa* Police Department and Fire Department

Please note that personal information may be disclosed within the specifications of the Disaster Control Plan, even if there was no consent provided in times of emergency.

Applicable Citizens will Receive Notification

Those who are going to be registered from now will receive "List of Citizens Requiring Evacuation Assistance" (遊城にもとうとうようしまんしゃめいぼ (避難行動要支援者名簿) notice packet around December.

This notice, which includes information about the Basic Act on Disaster Control Measures, confirmation regarding the information that is kept, and the consent form is sent so that information can be offered to various agencies to be prepared for when an emergency occurs. This consent form should be signed and returned. Please send back to the *Kiki Kanri ka* (Crisis Management) section of Hamura City. NTT's 171 DISASTER LINE

for keeping in touch with your people in time of emergency

NTT (Nippon Telegraph and Telephone Corporation) provides a voice/text messaging service that is initiated when a major disaster occurs. The regular telecommunication is often interrupted in the disaster-stricken area. In such situation this service allows people to post and retrieve voice/text messages through telephone or web based system. An individual message account is made per phone number registered upon usage and it is accessible by concerned family and friends who know the registrant's phone number.

The voice messaging service is accessible only from within Japan, however the text messaging service, which is a web based service, can also be accessed from overseas and available in English, Korean or Chinese. To use these services, preliminary contract with NTT is not required.

It is strongly recommended that you print the English instructions and keep them in your emergency kit.

* These services are currently closed, but will be opened in the event of an emergency.

The service can also be used from mobile phones, but please check the details with the provider of your communication device.

- ① Dial 171
- ② Choose whether to record or to playback : Record > "1" Playback > "2"

To record/playback using a PIN : Record > "3" Playback > "4" then input four-digit PIN

- ③ Enter the phone number of the person in the disaster-stricken area, starting with the area code.
 - → Your attempt will be connected to the message dial center.
- ④ After prompt is played, if calling from touch-tone phone press 1 and #, if calling from dial-tone phone just remain on the line. Then...

Recording: after the beep, speak your voice message. When finished, press 9 and #, or hang up.

- Playback: a voice message recorded in the accessed account will be played.
- * The automated voice prompts are played in Japanese only.

J-ALERT NATIONWIDE TEST BROADCASTING

J-Alert nationwide test broadcasting will take place on <u>August 29th (Wed) around 11AM</u>. Through the citywide public address system, you will hear the following Japanese announcements. <u>Inguiry</u>: *Kikikanri-ka Kikikanri-kakari* **2**Ext.217

This is a Hamura City Emergency Preparedness Organization (once)

Followed by the alert sirens. (to 53 locations in the city)

J-Alert (全国瞬時警報システム) is a nationwide alert system designed to deliver alert for most critical emergency by broadcasting it through local community wireless system without taking authorizing procedures at local government level in the event that requires citizens to beware of sudden emergency or to quickly evacuate or shelter themselves.

The alert information is distributed via satellite-based transmission system. When a local terminal receives the alert, it automatically activates the community wireless system, enabling the central government to directly and quickly inform its' citizens of imminent threats. The alert information that is announced may be for; earthquake (early warning, hypocenter, magnitude), weather alerts such as torrential rains or storms (precaution, presence), volcano eruption, significant meteorological disaster and military threats.

< National Health Insurance Expense Report >

If you are a National Health Insurance member who has received medical service in May and/or received physical therapy from a judo healing practitioner, and your total co-pay medical fee in those months was more than ¥3000, you will receive National Health Insurance (NHI) Medical Expense Report (国民健康保険医 療費通知) by mail. It is a letter from municipal government to N.H.I. insured persons which notifies his/her record of received medical services under N.H.I. policy coverage, with the list of original medical service fees at 100%, the amount before the insurance coverage was applied.

This report is issued in purpose of promoting the understanding of N.H.I. coverage system as well as the awareness of health management importance. There is no required procedure to be done with this report. Inquiries: Shimin-ka Hoken-kakari, TExt.129

< Extension of The Payment Period of National Pension Premiums Will No Longer Be Accepted> National Pension Premiums payment can be back paid up to (due date extending back to) 5 years for your delinquent premiums, thus changing the policy to a "5 Year Back Pay Policy". Under the current National Pension Plan (*Kokumin Nenkin*) system, the late premium payment is accepted only within 2 years from the payment due month. However, payment for delinquent payments for up to 5 years is possible under the "5 Year" measure. This special measure will be terminated on September 30th, 2018. Since the 30th falls on a Sunday, applications must be received by the 28th (Fri) to become eligible under the policy. You must notify the Pension Office of delinquency status, and follow procedures prior to making back-payments under the system.
