### < Renewal of Single-Parent Medical Support Certificate >

New \( \mathbb{R} \) Single-Parent Medical Support Certificate (Pink) will take effect from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019.

The new card will be mailed to applicable households in the late December. Please return the old certificate (purple) to *Kosodate Shien-ka* by mail or in person. If there are any changes in your registered status as in cases listed below, please report immediately. If you delay to report a change that affects beneficiary eligibility, the office may demand the return of subsidy provided after the status change.

- ① Change of the household member and/or house address.
- ② Change with the medical insurance coverage
- ③ Subsidy beneficiary\* is admitted to a care institution
- Subsidy beneficiary\* is issued with a Medical Support Certificate for Person with Disability
- ⑤ Subsidy beneficiary's\* parent is in state of common-law marriage (de facto marriage)
- \*If any of case ③,④,or ⑤ applies, the beneficiary is no longer eligible to this medical support program.
- \*You may be ineligible for term which status was not confirmed, therefore asked to return fees.
- \*Current beneficiaries who still have not completed the status report must submit the report immediately.

- ① Pregnant, or possibility of pregnancy ② Currently being treated for stomach or lung illness

- 4 If you have taken this screening already offered by *Hamura* City.

### 国民健康保険医療費通知の送付

### < National Health Insurance Medical Expense Report >

If you have received medical service in September and/or received physical therapy from a judo healing practitioner in September, and the total medical fee in those months was more than ¥3000, you will receive National Health Insurance (NHI) Medical Expense Report (国民健康保険医療費通知) by mail.

It is a letter from municipal government to NHI members which notifies his/her record of received medical services (only the services applicable to NHI coverage), with the list of original medical service fees at 100% (amount before the insurance coverage was applied).

This report is issued in purpose of promoting the understanding of NHI coverage system as well as the awareness of health management importance. There is no required procedure to be done concerning this report. <u>Inquiries</u>: City Hall, *Shimin-ka Hoken-kakari* **E**Ext.129

### < The "My Number" News № 18 > マイナンバーニュースNo. 18

~ The Network for Information Sharing Among National and Local Municipal Organizations under the Number System for Tax /Social Security System

The online network allows the various agencies to exchange the resident registry of citizens' data to deal with administrative procedures, and this information-sharing network abiding to rules for privacy policy is used at national and regional agencies and applied to carry out the tasks under the new system. Use of this system will be beneficial as below by saving time and lessening the number of documents that need to be prepared. (There will be cases in which accompanying documents are necessary for administrative procedures.)

- 1) My number card may use to be Identification card when you need to apply administration documents.
- 2) Allow to apply Certificate of Residence or others certificates in convenience stores which have set up Multi Copy Machine through My Number Card. (Daily 6:30AM~11PM except End & Beginning of Year and system maintenance day)
- Users need to register Electronic Certificate System 4 digits passport words to process but it is not available for under age 15 to use.
- 3) User may use My Portal Services to get one's own administrative information through website which is able to identify own self to process administration procedures.

<Hamura City's Evacuation Plan to Support Those Requiring Evacuation Assistance (遊難行動要支援者制度) > There is an evacuation assistance plan activated during a disaster for citizens requiring special consideration such as elderly citizens, physically or mentally challenged citizens, and some foreigners residing in Japan with difficulty to understand Japanese. They will be included in the list of citizens requiring evacuation assistance maintained by Hamura City, which provides a basis for cooperating agencies to be aware of their presence so that they can provide prompt support that these people need.

Please note that this registration system does not guarantee you will receive a special assistance in time of a disaster. It will provide disaster response personnel where the registered help-needing persons are likely to be found by their addresses, but those personnel may not be able to reach them swiftly.

It is most recommended for residents to have a friendly relationship with neighborhood people regularly in order to build a network for collecting local information and helping each other.

# Applicable Citizens will Receive Notification

Those who will be included in the List of Citizens Requiring Evacuation Assistance (避難行動要支援者名簿) will receive a notice in December.

This notice includes information about the Basic Act on Disaster Control Measure, confirmation regarding the information that is kept, and the consent form. This consent form that requests approval for the various agencies to handle the information should be signed and returned. Please send it back to the *Kiki Kanri ka* (Crisis Management) section of Hamura City. However, smaller items that cannot be processed (crushed) with machinery are also considered oversized trash. Examples of such items are listed on the bottom-half part of Hamura Trash Recycling Manual. Some home appliances, such as video players, electric heaters, rice cookers, vacuum cleaners and etc., are often mistaken as oversized trash. These appliances, as well as umbrellas, can be disposed as non-burnable trash.
