THINKING ABOUT THE EVIRONMENT SERIES

第110回「地球にやさしいお買い物」

Episode 110 [Earth Friendly Shopping]

Cool: Is there anything you are conscious of when you buy food?

Eco: I just buy what I want to eat without conscious about anything.

Cool: Actually, depending on how you choose, the environmental burden on the earth may increase. For example, eating summer vegetables such as tomatoes in winter or winter vegetables such as radishes in summer requires using air conditioning during the cultivation process, which emits a lot of CO2.

Eco: I see. Tomatoes and radishes are sold all year round, so I had never thought about it.

Cool: I think it's not just you but many people. We eat summer foods in summer and winter foods in winter.

This is called "Seasonal production for Seasonal consumption". Food in season tastes better and more nutritious.

Eco: I have heard of "Local production for Local consumption," but there is also the concept of "Seasonal production for Seasonal consumption!

Cool: One more thing, Eco, do you know the words of "food mileage"?

Eco: What is that?

Cool: Food mileage is a measure of how much CO2 is emitted by the time food reaches us, expressed as weight (tons) x distance (kilometers) of transportation.

The smaller the value, the lower the CO2 emissions. The smaller the value, the lower the CO2 emission and the more environmentally friendly. The shorter the transportation distance, the smaller the value. In other words, if we try to "Locally produce for Locally consume," we can be more environmentally friendly.

Eco: But I have never seen such lebelling at store.

Cool: It's true that you don't see such labels in stores. But since the place of origin is written on food products, it will make a difference if you are conscious of buying domestically produced foods rather than foreign produced, or those that are produced in a prefecture close to you.

Eco: That's right! From now on, I will pay attention to the season and origin place of food and try to "shop

earth-friendly!".

熱中症予防行動を強化しよう!

<Let's reinforce heat stroke prevention behaviors!>

According to the Fire and Disaster Management Agency, elderly people account for more than half of those who are transported to emergency rooms due to heat stroke.

With residences accounting for 40% of occurrence place, caution should be exercised even when at home. According to forecasts by the Japan Meteorological Agency, there is a high possibility that this summer will be another hot, so we need to be vigilant against heat stroke.

[Preventive Actions against Heat Stroke] 【熱中症予防行動】

- O Use air conditioners and fans effectively.
- O Drink water frequently even if you are not thirsty. 1.2 liters (about 6 glasses) per day is a good guideline.
- O Take water with you when you go out, and drink frequently before you become thirsty.
- O Check the weather and heat stroke information and avoid going out when a heat stroke alert is issued.
- O Wear cool clothing, use a parasol or hat and walk along shaded areas when going out.

O Try to go out in the morning or evening when the sun is low in the sky.

[Cooling Shelters (Designated Heat Evacuation Facilities)] [クーリングシェルター(指定暑熱避難施設)の活用]

The city has designated 12 facilities as cooling shelters, check the Hamura News ver. July 15th to get locations. Please use them as temporary resting places to avoid the heat when going out.

<Partial subsidies for adult vaccinations against Rubella (Fuushinn)>

Two types of subsidized projects are available for adult rubella vaccinations.

(1) Additional measures against rubella 風しん追加的対策事業

Eligibility: Males were born between April 2nd, 1962 and April 1st, 1979 who have not been tested for rubella

- * Antibody tests and vaccinations are available at medical institutions nationwide that participate in the coupon voucher program. For details, please visit the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare website.
- Coupons were sent to those who are eligible for the program in FY2021. Even if the coupon is expired, it can still be used at medical institutions. If you do not have a coupon ticket due to moving in or losing, please come to the Health Center.
- ※ If you move out of Hamura City, the coupon will no longer be valid.

The following persons can receive subsidies for antibody tests and vaccinations:

Eligibility: Those who are 19 years old or older, reside in Hamura and meet any of the following conditions

- ① Women who are planning or hoping to become pregnant.
- 2 Those who live with a pregnant woman.
- 3 Those who live together with the person in (1) above.

Subsidy amount:

- O Antibody test: Full cost (some at their own expense).
- O Measles and rubella combined vaccine: JPY5,000
- O Rubella vaccine: JPY3,000
- Application must be made in advance at Kenko Ka. For details for application, medical institutions in the city, etc., please visit the city's official website or inquiry.
- Pregnant women and those who may become pregnant are not eligible for the vaccination.
- Pregnancy must be avoided for two months after the vaccination.

(3) Common items

Only those who have undergone antibody testing and have low antibody titers can receive subsidized vaccinations.

The person loses a place to live outside the home, such as employment or school for an extended period. In general, this is the state of remaining generally at home for six months or longer. "Hikikomori" will happen for anyone who may suffer from it.

Depending on the context of the consultation, the city, in cooperation with the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, refers people to the "Tokyo Hikikomori Support Net" which is a network of related organizations and specialized institutions. In addition, the "Consultation Service for Living Independence" provides consultation on economic matters and problems related to daily and social life for those who have financial difficulties and withdrawal consultation is also available.


