### <80 Years After the War Mini Column>

戦争当時の羽村。羽村の農業



#### What was Hamura like during the war? Hamura's agriculture.

During the war, crops like wheat, sweet potatoes, and potatoes were collected at Hamura Station as contributions to the state and inspected by the Food Office.

Related to these contributions, we gathered acorns and tea seeds to send to school. Dozens of sacks filled with them piled up in the corner of the hallway, but we never knew what they were ultimately used for. Farmers worked hard to increase production, but fertilizer was scarce, and the soil only grew poorer. To compensate, truckloads of human waste fertilizer were sent from Tokyo, and farmers shared it among themselves. However, around 1944, gasoline shortages began, and truck deliveries ceased.

Furthermore, rationed food alone was insufficient, so many people came to Hamura to buy supplies. Farmers reportedly sold small amounts of leftover sweet potatoes, potatoes, and other crops, as well as portions for their own use. However, food was subject to police crackdowns. Food bought by those coming to Hamura was confiscated at the station, and the farmers who sold it reportedly received severe reprimands.

On the other hand, the farmers themselves couldn't survive on just what they produced and relied almost entirely on rationed food.

## THINKING ABOUT THE ENVIRONMENT SERIES

第125回サンゴ礁の危険

### <Episode. 125th Coral Reef Crisis>

Cool: This year's intense heat has caused major damage to crops, right? But there are also strange things happening in the ocean.

Eco : I know the sea temperature is rising.

Cool: Eco, Coral reefs are home to many fish and act as natural breakwaters, protecting coastlines from erosion. But they're in trouble now.

Eco : Oh, really?

Cool: The ideal water temperature for coral is 25~28°C. But if it stays above 30°C too long, the coral turns white, leaving only its skeleton. It was called [coral bleaching]. If the bleaching lasts about 2 months, the coral dies.

Eco : Huh, I always thought coral lived in warm seas, but it can't survive being too hot either.

Cool: Data from the Japan Meteorological Agency shows the average sea surface temperature in the southern East China Sea has risen by 1.24°C over the last 100 years. This rise is too harsh for coral.

Eco : We can manage even on scorching days thanks to air conditioning, but coral can't just escape to cooler places.

Cool: In 2024, over 87% of the coral in Ishigaki Island bleached. While it takes tens of thousands to tens of millions of years for coral reefs to form but die off in just a few months. Living coral reefs are vital fishing grounds, home to many fishes and are deeply connected to our food supply.

Eco : I never thought coral reefs had much to do with me, but from now on, I want to seriously consider what I can do to prevent ocean temperatures from rising.

[Eligible Activities] Group use of parks, children's playgrounds, etc.

[Application Period] Applications open on the 1st day of the month, two months prior to the usage date.

[Application deadline] One week before the usage date.

(Example) For use on Oct 10th → Application period: Aug 1st ~ Oct 3rd.

[Application Method]

① Submit the "Park Activity Permit Application" to the S&D Sports Park Fujimi Clubhouse.

※ The "Park Activity Permit Application" can be downloaded from the city's official website or obtained at the Doboku Ka or the Clubhouse.

※ For use of green spaces or plazas, please contact the Doboku Ka (Civil Engineering Section).

② Pick up the permit at the S&D Sports Park Fujimi Clubhouse approximately one week after submitting the application.

#### [Case]

A message arrived via a membership-based SNS, urging participation in a donation-based investment group. Intending to start with JPY150,000, the victim transferred the money to the specified online bank. A few days later, JPY57,000 was deposited into account. Told that becoming a member would yield thousands of dollars in profits, then victim deposited JPY400,000. But, no profits were transferred. Even after making additional deposits, no transfers came through. When victim demanded a full refund, but lost contact with them. The victim want money back, but what should he/she do?

#### [Consumer Affairs Center Response]

Since the complainant only communicated via messaging app, they didn't know the other party's name or address. However, they knew the account details used for the transfer. We advised them to explain the situation to the bank, mention they had reported it to the police, request an account investigation and freeze. We also suggested that if they could still contact the other party, they should inform them of these steps taken and push them to cancel the membership and refund the money.

#### [Advice for Preventing Trouble]

##### ○ Be wary of get-rich-quick schemes promising "easy money" or "simple earnings"!

Don't take claims emphasizing only convenience or benefits at face value. You might be asked to pay fees under various pretexts to receive rewards. Firmly decline any money-making offers where the actual operation or mechanism is unclear.

##### ○ Interactions with unknown parties carry risks

If your only contact method is a messaging app and you don't know the other person's address or phone number, you may lose contact if trouble arises.

##### ○ If the transfer destination is a "personal account", recovering funds after transfer is difficult.

If you accidentally transfer money, you may be able to use the **[Wire Transfer Fraud Relief Act]**.

If you become a victim, it is crucial to promptly contact the police and the financial institution where the transfer was made.
